**Scope and Content:** This collection contains documents from the Special Police Commissariat. It includes lists of refugees by nationality, materials on internment facilities, and documents of the Bureau of Liaison with the German authorities and of the Renseignements généraux (the police agency watching

foreigners). Also included are documents on the persecution of Jews in the communes of Isle-Aumont and Ramerupt, and materials of the post-liberation Historical Commission on the Second World .

NA10641: The Aube Prefecture Historical Committee for the Second World War: Racial persecutions against the Jews; working notes of the historical committee concerning an estimate of the number of Jews deported from the Aube during the German occupation, 1967-1974. Contains study, notes, and names list. Frames 855-902.

SC6337: The Aube Prefecture, First Division, Third Office: Criblage regional commission; refugees in and transfers between the camps in Marmagne (Côte d'Or), Martigny (Vosges), and Le Vernet, 1939-1942. Frames 903-1644.

SC6343: The Aube Prefecture, First Division, Third Office: Census of foreign labor; statistics compiled by the German authorities. German Reich census; census of foreigners by nationality, profession, and family status [i.e. married, single, children, etc.] Census of foreigners and Alsaciens-Lorrains at liberation. Statistics on Jews, German émigrés, and naturalized citizens from 1933-1940. The file opened on 1 January 2006: Circulars, administrative correspondence, statistics, name lists, and the gendarmerie report. Frames 1645-2386.

SC9755: The Aube Prefecture, Office of the Prefect: Dissolution of the Masonic lodges. Accounting of VIP's and officers living in the Aube department who appear in the Official Journal of 1941. Administrative information cards (30 cards with information on front and back) 1941-1944. Declarations concerning secret societies that were never sent, 1944. Correspondence and administrative files, 1941-1944. Frames 2387-2713.

SC9760: The Aube Prefecture, Office of the Prefect: Dissolution of the Masonic lodges; circulars, orders, press clippings, administrative correspondence, 2714-2777. Frames 2714-2777.

SC46553: Financial services office: circulars concerning the sequestration and restitution of Jewish goods [spoiled] during the war. Frames 2778-3534.

100W1: The Aube prefecture special police precinct: Refugee hostels set up at the Jules Ferry and Diderot schools in Troyes; operation and organization, lists, police inquiries, transfers of French, British, Belgian, Dutch, Polish, Ukrainian, Russian, Czech, Yugoslav, Bulgarian, Rumanian, German, Austrian, Greek, Turk, Palestinian, stateless, and Jewish refugees, 1940-1941. Police reports, administrative correspondence, name lists, and telephone transcripts, 1940-1941. Frames 1-140.
