**Organization and arrangement:** Arrangement is thematic.

**Language:** In French and German.

**Preferred citation:** Standard citation for the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum, Curatorial Affairs Division, Archives Branch.

**Scope and Content:** Contains records directly linked to the war: internments for administrative or “political” reasons; purges; surveillance of political parties; freemasons (“Sociétés Secrètes”) and the press; food distribution and rationing; non-Jewish laborers requisitioned to work in Germany (“STO”); military affairs, prisoners; refugees; supervision of real estate transactions; sequestered property; affairs related to German or Italian occupation; war damages; veterans’ affairs; judicial matters and lawsuits; as well as the Armistice Commission. Also contains material indirectly related to the war: public health sector; police prefecture authority over foreigners; departments dealing with hospitals and government employees (“fonctionnaires”); the department of agriculture; public education; and court records.
