

1. MS over heads of women ex-prisoners waving and gesturing as lorry bearing SS goes past right to left.
2. MCU of Military Police Sign on roadside tree. 'DANGER TYPHUS'
3. CU of MP sign on post in field.
4. CUs of third sign, panning along letters of TYPHUS.
5. Frontal MCU of Schwimmwagen of 11 Light Field Ambulance parked inside women's compound. The vehicle bears a Red Cross flag.
6. MS, rear 3/4 view, shows woman speaking with driver. Drivers' companion has a cigarette.
7. CUs of driver, a Lt of the RAMC who has taken over the wheel from his companion, a RASC driver.
8. MLS of Martin Wilson talking with woman prisoner. In bg are British Army tents over which French flag is flying - another ~~scattered~~ and two male inmates form part of the group.
9. HA.MCU of Frenchman kneeling over a fire to prepare a meal. In right fg is a wooden board, reminiscent of a grave marker, which shelters the fire from the wind. On the ground beside him lies an enamel plate on which is a hunk of black bread. A German Army Troddel dangles from the man's waist, but otherwise, he is shabbily dressed.
10. HA.MS as bulldozer, moving right to left, pushes a heap of bodies before it into a common grave. Camera pans to follow as the bodies tumble down into the pit.
11. MS as M.E.S. bulldozer advances diagonally left to right, scooping up bodies. One corpse, lying head on in the tractor's path, is forced up the face of the blade as the vehicle moves forward.
12. CU of RE driver Wrinn of Hoddington, Scotland, as he spits over the side of the tractor - vehicle moving diagonally left to right through frame.
13. MCU of Wrinn at the controls - he is smoking.
14. MS as bulldozer ploughs through a heap of bodies, scooping up some while others fall away to the right of the vehicle. Camera pans to follow the tractor; the blade is set too high and the bodies slip beneath the vehicle, leaving only one still held in the hollow of the blade.
15. CU of driver Wrinn at the controls. He appears distraught.
16. HA.MCU from tractor as the blade scoops up bodies and pushes them along. Focus slightly blurred.
17. CU as driver spits again, to clear his mouth.
18. CU profile of driver Wrinn as he lights a cigarette. The matches are German, 'WELT-HÖLZER' brand. He inhales deeply.
19. Rear 3/4 CUs of bulldozer entering frame lower left to shovel bodies over lip of mass grave.

20. MS of relief driver, Driver Burridge of Todmorton, Yorks. He holds a petrol soaked handkerchief over his nose and mouth, [A700/304/4-6, shot 19], while controlling the tractor with his other hand.
21. CU of hand on controls of bulldozer.
22. A former prisoner watches the burial. Rear 3/4 CU of woman's head at frame left. She is wearing headscarf and dark glasses, and holds a handkerchief beneath her nose. She looks into frame towards tractor working in bg. Similar shot with head at frame right.
23. MS as bulldozer pushes soil onto heaped bodies.
24. MCU of same.
25. MCUs of women prisoners looking on.
26. MS as bulldozer blade moves diagonally left to right to plough into a heap of bodies. Some are thrown aside. Camera pans to follow tractor as it moves left to right, revealing Driver Burridge still holding handkerchief over nose and mouth.
27. MCU of Burridge driving with handkerchief worn as a mask. Vehicle moving left to right.
28. CU as bodies are pushed away by tractor. The cadavers are in an advanced state of decay.
29. MS of Humber 4x4 FWD Ambulance and trailer of 11 Light Field Ambulance. The driver of the ambulance shows a member of the decontamination squad the effects of a strafing attack by German fighters on the morning of 20 April, 1945. One shell has passed through the upper right quarter of the Red Cross roundel.
30. CU of shell hole in roundel, pointed out by the driver, and holes in ambulance trailer - one has passed through the vehicle serial number. The drivers companion is in full decontamination suit with hood and elbow-length gauntlets.
31. MS-CUs of a line of Hungarian guards digging trench-grave.
32. Interior of camp hut which served as an hospital prior to the arrival of British troops. Used for the confinement of Typhus victims. CU of sleeping child. Poor focus.
33. CU of face of woman lying on bed. Poor focus.
34. As above.
35. CU as small child has her hair combed. Poor focus.
36. CU of girl's face. Poor focus.
37. CU of small child crying. Poor focus.
38. CU as child's hair is cut by hospital barber. Poor focus.
39. MCU as woman doctor bandages the left wrist of a young boy.
40. MS of children standing and looking into camera which pans left and right over the group.

41. MCU of children and woman holding baby. The woman gestures and smiles into camera but the baby looks away without interest. Older children react more favourably.

42. MS through wire of perimeter fence to children who approach to look back at the cameraman.

43. MLS over a detachment of the Hungarian Garrison troops as they dig a new communal grave assisted by a British bulldozer which moves amongst the work crew.

44. MS of same, bulldozer moving towards the camera.

45. MLS of same - Hungarian officers stand watching their men.
