	<p>By now the signs are apparent of the efforts of the British to cope with the enormous problem of the resuscitation of the people of BELSEN CONCENTRATION CAMP. Water supplies are springing up for drinking and baths - hot baths.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>283/29/1.</u></p> <p>Mobile Bath Unit with members of BELSEN CONCENTRATION CAMP bathing. A British N.C.O. can be seen attending to the showers.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>283/29/2.</u></p> <p>Even now (22 Apr) the dead are still being buried by the SS troops. These shots show them at work under the guard of British soldiers. Last shots show Hungarian soldiers at work deepening one of the mass graves started a couple of days ago, watched by a British Officer.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>283/29/3.</u></p> <p>The first 40 feet or so are of one of the prisoners, A Czech Jewess (woman Interpreter) speaking to a British Officer. It is only now that they have begun to acquire the dignity of a people. Typhus Cases being carried from camp- they are placed on an ambulance, taken to a Delousing and Cleansing Station, then on to a clean ambulance and so to Hospital.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>283/29/4.</u></p> <p>Typhus case on arrival at Delousing and Cleansing Station. All interiors and light very dull. German medicals assist too and German nurses all working under our supervision.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>283/29/5.</u></p> <p>Mobile Bath Unit at work- also drinking water.</p>
