- Mt. ridge held by British front
- Shethar - British helmet Horton U.S. helmet.
- CCS - Tents - valley below Monte Grande and
- Group of us - John Greene, Lewis, Shethar, ??
- Monastery used as CCS, North of Fort (?) Eastern Italian front.
- Pisa staging area (Harrods Camp)
- On way to Marseilles - LST
- Landing at Marseilles.
- End - white cliffs of Dover

Belsen

- Entrance gate
- Assisting loading evacuation
AFS officer Jim Briggs (Probably?)
- Hungarians as stretcher bearers.
- Horton driver of this ambulance.
- ? Names of following ambulance drivers shown but driver with no cap and black hair is U. Greene.
- Trucks being loaded are camp Russians able enough to leave.
- Line up of German SS by AFS driver with officer's cap and trench coat (? name) - Tommies guarding.
We transported SS out, under guard by Tommies in our ambulances.
- British flame throwers burning debris and camps. Finally last camp was burned after evacuation was complete.
