8 00:00:24,480 --> 00:00:27,960 And as soon as they arrived in Auschwitz,

9 00:00:27,960 --> 00:00:31,380 the thousand children and the nurses and the doctors

10 00:00:31,380 --> 00:00:34,290 were immediately gassed.

11 00:00:34,290 --> 00:00:38,160 And when this story was told to me in Theresienstadt.

12 00:00:38,160 --> 00:00:42,900 The man who did it didn't understand what happened.

13 00:00:42,900 --> 00:00:49,510 For him, it was an ununderstandable story,

14 00:00:49,510 --> 00:00:51,600 a complete mystery.

15 00:00:51,600 --> 00:00:55,740 And after a while, I made for the film,

16 00:00:55,740 --> 00:01:01,950 too, an interview with the last president

17 00:01:01,950 --> 00:01:04,545 of the Judenrate of Theresienstadt,

18 00:01:04,545 --> 00:01:11,340 also the Judenaelteste, Dr. Benjamin Murmelstein.

19 00:01:11,340 --> 00:01:14,292 And I asked him if he knew--

20 00:01:14,292 --> 00:01:15,000 He knew about it.

21 00:01:15,000 --> 00:01:18,630 If he knew the truth with the--

22 00:01:18,630 --> 00:01:19,830 did he know?

23 00:01:19,830 --> 00:01:22,740 And he just told me the same, but he

24 00:01:22,740 --> 00:01:25,470 didn't know the reasons why.

25 00:01:25,470 --> 00:01:31,260 You are the one who were, here in Atlanta, to give me

26 00:01:31,260 --> 00:01:36,900 the key of this mystery.

27 00:01:36,900 --> 00:01:41,740 And you think that it is because you didn't pay to--

28 00:01:41,740 --> 00:01:48,630 this Wisliency is a first installment of \$100,000

29 00:01:48,630 --> 00:01:54,000 that the children were shipped to Auschwitz and gassed.

30 00:01:54,000 --> 00:01:56,130 No doubt about.

31 00:01:56,130 --> 00:01:59,040 That time, already that what made us really

32 00:01:59,040 --> 00:02:02,430 the first and very, very angry to see

33 00:02:02,430 --> 00:02:06,750 this absolute misunderstanding about our situation

34 00:02:06,750 --> 00:02:10,710 and the lack of confidence which we seemingly had in us.

35 00:02:10,710 --> 00:02:14,490 Because Gisi, Gisi Fleischmann, Rabbi Weissmandel, and myself, 36 00:02:14,490 --> 00:02:18,630 too, have been saying, so, God damn it, here we

37 00:02:18,630 --> 00:02:20,970 are doing nearly the incredible.

38 00:02:20,970 --> 00:02:23,520 And those who have nothing else to do just

39 00:02:23,520 --> 00:02:25,710 sent us a few hundred thousand dollars.

40 00:02:25,710 --> 00:02:29,250 Don't believe us and be covered for formalities

41 00:02:29,250 --> 00:02:33,090 are not helping us to make this so-called saving action.

42 00:02:33,090 --> 00:02:34,810 You say formalities.

43 00:02:34,810 --> 00:02:37,290 You mean that the people of the Joint,

44 00:02:37,290 --> 00:02:40,920 and particularly Saly Mayer in Switzerland,

45 00:02:40,920 --> 00:02:43,480 didn't understand at all what was at stake.

46 00:02:43,480 --> 00:02:46,920 I think that, because if he would have understood it, 47 00:02:46,920 --> 00:02:52,350 it was impossible that he would ask for so many formalities

48 00:02:52,350 --> 00:02:54,030 before he's willing to give the money.

49 00:02:54,030 --> 00:02:56,010 What did he ask exactly?

50 00:02:56,010 --> 00:03:00,540 He said that time that Gisi Fleischmann wrote him

51 00:03:00,540 --> 00:03:02,340 that according to our information,

52 00:03:02,340 --> 00:03:04,980 the children arrived in Theresienstadt.

53 00:03:04,980 --> 00:03:08,220 And the first hundred thousand dollars should be given.

54 00:03:08,220 --> 00:03:12,600 And again, some answer came from Saly Mayer

55 00:03:12,600 --> 00:03:15,450 which was sounding that, in his opinion,

56 00:03:15,450 --> 00:03:16,830 the Germans are playing with us.

57 00:03:16,830 --> 00:03:21,150 It is not true, and he cannot believe that-- 59 00:03:24,600 --> 00:03:26,340 simply the money was not here because he

60 00:03:26,340 --> 00:03:27,660 didn't believe in it.

61 00:03:27,660 --> 00:03:30,060 And what makes us angry so, that here

62 00:03:30,060 --> 00:03:32,100 was Gisi Fleischmann, a representative

63 00:03:32,100 --> 00:03:36,780 of American Joint in WIZO an old Zionist worker.

64 00:03:36,780 --> 00:03:40,080 Then he was Weissmandel who was in the absolutely the finest

65 00:03:40,080 --> 00:03:42,300 reputation in orthodoxy.

66 00:03:42,300 --> 00:03:47,250 And then myself who everybody knew that I have connections

67 00:03:47,250 --> 00:03:48,090 to the Germans.

68 00:03:48,090 --> 00:03:51,480 And up to now, everything what we did was true,

69 00:03:51,480 --> 00:03:55,890 and it was, we thought, checked and rechecked that it was true. 70 00:03:55,890 --> 00:03:59,280 And suddenly, in the most crucial moment, that we already

71 00:03:59,280 --> 00:04:02,610 had the first time saving 1,000 children,

72 00:04:02,610 --> 00:04:07,260 suddenly we couldn't confirm, couldn't implement it,

73 00:04:07,260 --> 00:04:12,390 because Saly Mayer was not willing to give us \$100,000.

74 00:04:12,390 --> 00:04:14,130 Because of this angriness, I think

75 00:04:14,130 --> 00:04:16,155 that was the time that Gisi Fleischmann too

76 00:04:16,155 --> 00:04:18,959 and Weissmandel started to write really very

77 00:04:18,959 --> 00:04:21,060 angry letters outside.

78 00:04:21,060 --> 00:04:24,240 And I very much like to quote from one of the letters

79 00:04:24,240 --> 00:04:25,680 which Gisi Fleischmann wrote where

80 00:04:25,680 --> 00:04:28,620 she lets us the following.

00:04:28,620 --> 00:04:32,370 And I want to read it first for you in German.

00:04:57,720 --> 00:04:58,500 Excuse me.

00:04:58,500 --> 00:05:00,270 Saly Mayer was called Uncle.

88

00:05:00,270 --> 00:05:01,500 It was a code name.

89

00:05:01,500 --> 00:05:02,410 That was a code name.

90

00:05:02,410 --> 00:05:05,040 That's right.

91

00:05:05,040 --> 00:05:08,160 I don't accuse you, dear Uncle, that you don't

92

00:05:08,160 --> 00:05:11,730 have an understanding for us, and still

93

00:05:11,730 --> 00:05:15,810 speaking about

old formulas which

94 00:05:15,810 --> 00:05:18,850 so often in the history of mankind,

95 00:05:18,850 --> 00:05:21,000 but especially in the story of the Jews,

96 00:05:21,000 --> 00:05:25,230 made it impossible to say what he wanted to say.

97 00:05:25,230 --> 00:05:28,260 But Weissmandel, I heard, I didn't read his letters,

98 00:05:28,260 --> 00:05:33,450 have been even much, much more beautiful and much more

99 00:05:33,450 --> 00:05:34,920 emotional.

100 00:05:34,920 --> 00:05:40,320 And we hoped that even if that suddenly didn't came through

101 00:05:40,320 --> 00:05:42,630 that we would be able to say and go

102 00:05:42,630 --> 00:05:47,080 back again to the Europa Plan and make that really a reality.

103 00:05:47,080 --> 00:05:51,390 What Wisliency exactly told you about the gassing

104 00:05:51,390 --> 00:05:53,250 of the children? 105 00:05:53,250 --> 00:05:58,170 Wisliency simply said that at the very moment if you cannot

106 00:05:58,170 --> 00:06:00,405 pay, so you are not going to get the children.

107 00:06:00,405 --> 00:06:02,280 What happens that year and if you didn't know

108 00:06:02,280 --> 00:06:04,440 I don't know whether Wisliency knew

109 00:06:04,440 --> 00:06:07,150 that what you told me right now or he didn't want

110 00:06:07,150 --> 00:06:10,090 to go tell us, I don't know.

111 00:06:10,090 --> 00:06:12,510 In truth of the matter is if, I remember right,

112 00:06:12,510 --> 00:06:13,440 we didn't even press.

113 00:06:13,440 --> 00:06:18,060 We have been so absolutely stunned

114 00:06:18,060 --> 00:06:22,350 that we couldn't bring up this \$200,000 for 1,000 children,

115 00:06:22,350 --> 00:06:23,820 that we completely dropped it. 00:06:23,820 --> 00:06:28,110 And you couldn't find the money with the so-called--

117 00:06:28,110 --> 00:06:29,880 [INTERPOSING VOICES]

118 00:06:29,880 --> 00:06:32,880 No, because they didn't have that type of money.

119 00:06:32,880 --> 00:06:35,850 Even if you would take out everything what Slovakia had,

120 00:06:35,850 --> 00:06:38,130 we just couldn't get it together.

121 00:06:38,130 --> 00:06:41,190 We hoped that through the Gisi Fleischmann, as you know,

122 00:06:41,190 --> 00:06:43,860 was twice in Budapest and tried to get money

123 00:06:43,860 --> 00:06:46,090 and tried to get money from there.

124 00:06:46,090 --> 00:06:47,330 From the Jews from Hungary.

125 00:06:47,330 --> 00:06:49,050 From the Jews from Hungary because we

126 00:06:49,050 --> 00:06:51,900 knew that the Jews from Hungary have been very, very rich,

127 00:06:51,900 --> 00:06:55,920 and even \$200,000 would have been easy to get it.

128

00:06:55,920 --> 00:06:58,230 It was rather quiet at the time.

129 00:06:58,230 --> 00:07:00,510 And that time, it

was quiet, and they

130 00:07:00,510 --> 00:07:04,170 didn't believe that the whole trouble going

131 00:07:04,170 --> 00:07:05,160 to be in Hungary, too.

132 00:07:05,160 --> 00:07:08,550 And we told them, don't try now to think, and don't be naive.

133 00:07:08,550 --> 00:07:10,410 There's not going to happen to you, too,

134 00:07:10,410 --> 00:07:12,840 so that everything what you would give us

135 00:07:12,840 --> 00:07:17,640 would be a saving action for different children.

136 00:07:17,640 --> 00:07:21,270 But Hungary, again, wanted to send us money officially,

137 00:07:21,270 --> 00:07:23,610 goes to the National Bank.

138 00:07:23,610 --> 00:07:26,190 And from the Hungarian National Bank, 139 00:07:26,190 --> 00:07:28,320 send it to the Slovak National Bank.

140 00:07:28,320 --> 00:07:29,360 You mean that the Jews.

141 00:07:29,360 --> 00:07:31,120 The Jews, yeah.

142 00:07:31,120 --> 00:07:33,583 So they wanted to do the thing in a bureaucratic way.

143 00:07:33,583 --> 00:07:34,500 In a bureaucratic way.

144 00:07:34,500 --> 00:07:37,020 And they don't understand that we cannot use that type

145 00:07:37,020 --> 00:07:39,130 of money.

146 00:07:39,130 --> 00:07:41,010 So that really we just didn't have the money,

147 00:07:41,010 --> 00:07:44,580 but we really hoped that by having children,

148 00:07:44,580 --> 00:07:48,330 by having that first test, what can Wisliency

149 00:07:48,330 --> 00:07:53,430 really do to implement would be important enough in connection

150 00:07:53,430 --> 00:07:58,230 with the whole Europa plan to put it down and later have

151 00:07:58,230 --> 00:08:00,870 time enough to bring the \$2 million,

152 00:08:00,870 --> 00:08:06,180 which was supposed to be given to them for the Europa plan.

153 00:08:06,180 --> 00:08:09,450 Did Gisi Fleischmann told you exactly

154 00:08:09,450 --> 00:08:11,760 about her trip in Hungaria?

155 00:08:11,760 --> 00:08:12,960 How was she received?

156 00:08:12,960 --> 00:08:17,940

157 00:08:17,940 --> 00:08:20,970 Oh, how she was received in Hungary?

158 00:08:20,970 --> 00:08:22,140 Oh, yeah, sure.

159 00:08:22,140 --> 00:08:25,260 She was first, one of the first visit

160 00:08:25,260 --> 00:08:27,750 was and just like Hungarians, I know

161 00:08:27,750 --> 00:08:31,980 that every pomp and every glory was given to her.

00:08:31,980 --> 00:08:33,973 And she told us after that she--

163

00:08:33,973 --> 00:08:34,890 The Jews from Hungary.

164

00:08:34,890 --> 00:08:36,240 The Jews from Hungary.

165

00:08:36,240 --> 00:08:39,010 That Freudiger and Kasztner and all

166

00:08:39,010 --> 00:08:41,669 lived, so that it's again the orthodoxy

167

00:08:41,669 --> 00:08:45,060 and the Zionist had a wonderful meeting with her.

168

00:08:45,060 --> 00:08:47,985 There was a big dinner with all the ladies

169

00:08:47,985 --> 00:08:50,912 there with beautiful dresses and the diamonds and so on,

170

00:08:50,912 --> 00:08:52,620 just like in a good old time like nothing

171

00:08:52,620 --> 00:08:54,190 would go on in the whole world.

172

00:08:54,190 --> 00:08:54,750 Unbelievable.

173

00:08:54,750 --> 00:08:55,530 Unbelievable.

Unbelievable.

174 00:08:55,530 --> 00:08:58,170 She came back exactly, and she said the same word

175 00:08:58,170 --> 00:09:01,590 that she just couldn't believe that in the same time

176 00:09:01,590 --> 00:09:04,740 as we are going through that type of difficulty a little bit

177 00:09:04,740 --> 00:09:08,190 away from the border, that kind of behavior

178 00:09:08,190 --> 00:09:12,130 went on in the Hungarian Jews.

179 00:09:12,130 --> 00:09:13,590 They gave her a big dinner.

180 00:09:13,590 --> 00:09:17,940 They gave her a big dinner and a big pomp and big speeches

181 00:09:17,940 --> 00:09:21,900 and promises that they are going to make a fundraising.

182 00:09:21,900 --> 00:09:24,000 But after the fundraising was promised,

183 00:09:24,000 --> 00:09:26,160 it was said, yes, brown fundraising,

184 00:09:26,160 --> 00:09:29,580 but the money we can send to you only on the official channels. 00:09:29,580 --> 00:09:32,595 We cannot give it to you for underground activities

186 00:09:32,595 --> 00:09:33,630 in underground channels.

187 00:09:33,630 --> 00:09:35,700 But why, because they were afraid?

188 00:09:35,700 --> 00:09:36,990 Because it was not legal?

189 00:09:36,990 --> 00:09:38,050 What?

190 00:09:38,050 --> 00:09:39,450 But because it was illegal.

191 00:09:39,450 --> 00:09:42,630 And therefore, they foolishly thought

192 00:09:42,630 --> 00:09:46,350 that they are going to hurt their position if that

193 00:09:46,350 --> 00:09:48,000 would do some illegal actions.

194 00:09:48,000 --> 00:09:49,110 To harm their position.

195 00:09:49,110 --> 00:09:50,640 To harm their own position.

196 00:09:50,640 --> 00:09:52,830 And Gisi Fleischmann tried to explain to them

197 00:09:52,830 --> 00:09:55,950 that it is absolutely, first of all, not true.

198 00:09:55,950 --> 00:09:59,280 That it would not harm, and just the contrary.

199 00:09:59,280 --> 00:10:03,930 They would eventually be able to see similar things

200 00:10:03,930 --> 00:10:06,350 and to do similar things in Hungary

201 00:10:06,350 --> 00:10:09,740 if the same action comes to them to, too.

202 00:10:09,740 --> 00:10:13,530 Yes, and one year and a half later, it was after.

203 00:10:13,530 --> 00:10:15,740 A half a year later, it happened what

204 00:10:15,740 --> 00:10:17,630 we had a feeling that whether they

205 00:10:17,630 --> 00:10:24,950 are able to stop deportation and make it not only to a Slovak

206 00:10:24,950 --> 00:10:29,510 venture, but the Slovak sample, an example,

207 00:10:29,510 --> 00:10:32,530 could be carried to the other countries, too.

208

00:10:32,530 --> 00:10:33,830 Yes.

209

00:10:33,830 --> 00:10:39,320 And there is something which I find very, very interesting

210

00:10:39,320 --> 00:10:43,160 and very unique because these ideas or the Europa plan,

211

00:10:43,160 --> 00:10:49,147 this means to save all the Jews who could be saved.

212

00:10:49,147 --> 00:10:50,480 Remained in Europe at that time.

213

00:10:50,480 --> 00:10:50,980 Yes.

214

00:10:50,980 --> 00:10:54,680 Without choosing who will be saved.

215

00:10:54,680 --> 00:10:56,690 The idea was to save everybody.

216

00:10:56,690 --> 00:10:57,290 Yeah.

217

00:10:57,290 --> 00:10:58,832 Now that is really interesting for me

218

00:10:58,832 --> 00:11:05,390 because we, in Slovakia, we felt that we have been really

219

00:11:05,390 --> 00:11:09,980 not after saving a selected persons or selected families.

00:11:39,490 --> 00:11:40,450 That correct.

229

00:11:40,450 --> 00:11:45,820 The other group, the working group's idea was that we cannot

230

00:11:45,820 --> 00:11:47,290 play God.

231

00:11:47,290 --> 00:11:48,250 God, you mean.

232

00:11:48,250 --> 00:11:48,790

Pardon?

233

00:11:48,790 --> 00:11:49,290

God.

234

00:11:49,290 --> 00:11:51,520

God, yeah, we cannot play God.

235

00:11:51,520 --> 00:11:54,280

And that why we all the time said

236

00:11:54,280 --> 00:11:55,930

we speak about the communities.

237

00:11:55,930 --> 00:11:57,700

We speak about the Jewish community

238

00:11:57,700 --> 00:12:00,310

in the different

European countries

239

 $00:12:00,310 \longrightarrow 00:12:02,450$

without making selections.

240

00:12:02,450 --> 00:12:05,470

And that was, basically,

the big moral difference

241

00:12:05,470 --> 00:12:11,710

between how we worked and how

the Hungarian Jews worked.

242

00:12:11,710 --> 00:12:15,730

Because from the beginning,

we heard about it

243

00:12:15,730 --> 00:12:18,890

that Kasztner and

even Freudiger,

00:12:18,890 --> 00:12:23,120 too, started to put together a special transport, I think,

245

00:12:23,120 --> 00:12:26,330 for 1,600 or 2,000 people.

246

00:12:26,330 --> 00:12:26,830 No, no, no.

247

00:12:26,830 --> 00:12:28,620 It was, yeah, 1,600.

248

00:12:28,620 --> 00:12:29,120 1,600.

249

00:12:29,120 --> 00:12:30,070 Yes.

250

00:12:30,070 --> 00:12:32,840 And we heard that, from the beginning,

251

00:12:32,840 --> 00:12:37,060 they tried to make selection, and not only selection

252

00:12:37,060 --> 00:12:41,050 from some special meritable Jews who

253

00:12:41,050 --> 00:12:44,740 merited for some reason, many of the rich Jews who

254

00:12:44,740 --> 00:12:49,840 had been able to pay for it, then selected Zionist leaders

255

00:12:49,840 --> 00:12:53,420 and selected artists and so-called high intellectuals.

00:12:53,420 --> 00:12:54,940 And their own families, too.

257

00:12:54,940 --> 00:12:56,770 And their own families, too.

258

00:12:56,770 --> 00:13:00,410 And we had been absolutely against that type of action.

259

00:13:00,410 --> 00:13:02,770 And I think, if I not I am not mistaken,

260

00:13:02,770 --> 00:13:08,230 even Wisliency told me once that he appreciated

261

00:13:08,230 --> 00:13:12,640 our fact that the only special transport we asked

262

00:13:12,640 --> 00:13:16,360 was children, a group children.

263

00:13:16,360 --> 00:13:19,270 But we never ask anybody anything for ourselves,

264

00:13:19,270 --> 00:13:22,360 and we never ask anything for our friends or some selected

265

00:13:22,360 --> 00:13:24,190 individuals.

266

00:13:24,190 --> 00:13:26,950 And that why we, very often, even wrote

267

00:13:26,950 --> 00:13:30,535 to Kasztner and Freudiger that

00:13:30,535 --> 00:13:33,760 we had been working because this is already, even

269

00:13:33,760 --> 00:13:35,710 from moral standpoint that I had seen,

270

00:13:35,710 --> 00:13:38,710 and that is the accepted route from the Germans, too.

271

00:13:38,710 --> 00:13:40,570 And that should not spoil it because we

272

00:13:40,570 --> 00:13:43,810 are afraid that that just wouldn't work in the ways

273

00:13:43,810 --> 00:13:46,370 as we had we hat it in mind.

274

00:13:46,370 --> 00:13:49,720 And the Hungarian Jews, I mean, the Hungarian Judenrat,

275

00:13:49,720 --> 00:13:55,690 as a matter of fact, Kasztner, Philip von Freudiger, all

276

00:13:55,690 --> 00:13:58,630 these people, when they were already what you mean,

277

00:13:58,630 --> 00:14:02,900 when they were in negotiations with Eichmann.

278

00:14:02,900 --> 00:14:05,710

This was much later.

279 00:14:05,710 --> 00:14:10,210 It was in 1944 when the deportations from Hungaria

280

00:14:10,210 --> 00:14:13,210 were going at full speed.

281

00:14:13,210 --> 00:14:15,025 They decided to select--

282

00:14:15,025 --> 00:14:18,640 it's what they called the kind of Ark of Noah of Jews.

283

00:14:18,640 --> 00:14:20,140 That's right.

284

00:14:20,140 --> 00:14:23,020 And knew it was completely it was a way around.

285

00:14:23,020 --> 00:14:24,200 The other way around.

286

00:14:24,200 --> 00:14:26,230 We didn't want to make an Ark of Noah.

287

00:14:26,230 --> 00:14:28,000 We didn't want to select anybody.

288

00:14:28,000 --> 00:14:30,700 We wanted to have the community, and we

289

00:14:30,700 --> 00:14:34,270 thought if for any reason that wouldn't go, then

290

00:14:34,270 --> 00:14:38,950

we have time enough to arrange later to make some compromise.

291

00:14:38,950 --> 00:14:41,890 But from the beginning, our aim was

292

00:14:41,890 --> 00:14:44,650 to stop deportation for the different Jewish communities

293

00:14:44,650 --> 00:14:46,780 in different European States.

294

00:14:46,780 --> 00:14:51,490 But what do you think it was say that one

295

00:14:51,490 --> 00:14:57,400 of the main concern of Weissmandel

296

00:14:57,400 --> 00:15:01,420 and generally speaking of the Orthodox Jews

297

00:15:01,420 --> 00:15:07,330 was to save the Orthodox Jews mostly for Weissmandel.

298

00:15:07,330 --> 00:15:09,970 It was said that he wanted to save mostly

299

00:15:09,970 --> 00:15:12,520 the people of the yeshiva.

300

00:15:12,520 --> 00:15:14,260 I didn't have this impression, though.

301

00:15:14,260 --> 00:15:18,340 I had the impression that

00:15:18,340 --> 00:15:23,530 he, but he was one of those who said we should not play God

303

00:15:23,530 --> 00:15:26,140 by selecting, that we are going to speak

304

00:15:26,140 --> 00:15:29,230 about the Jewish community.

305

00:15:29,230 --> 00:15:32,500 I don't think so that he even he never proposed.

306

00:15:32,500 --> 00:15:36,280 I don't know of any case where he proposed in any saving

307

00:15:36,280 --> 00:15:39,180 action to make special mention about the Orthodox Jews.

308

00:15:39,180 --> 00:15:41,614 Is formula, we cannot play God?

309

00:15:41,614 --> 00:15:42,562 That's a formula.

310

00:15:42,562 --> 00:15:43,510 That's correct.

311

00:15:43,510 --> 00:15:46,690 That's Weissmandel's formula that we cannot select,

312

00:15:46,690 --> 00:15:50,080 we cannot play God, and let we speak about

00:15:50,080 --> 00:15:51,720 for the communities.

314

00:15:51,720 --> 00:15:53,470 And you think that he would have preferred

315

00:15:53,470 --> 00:15:56,680 to have the whole community destroyed

316

00:15:56,680 --> 00:16:00,130 than to save just a small part?

317

00:16:00,130 --> 00:16:04,330 The idea was that if it doesn't work,

318

00:16:04,330 --> 00:16:06,820 we are not able to save the whole community.

319

00:16:06,820 --> 00:16:09,550 And the Germans would say we cannot give you one million

320

00:16:09,550 --> 00:16:14,080 Jews, that we will be able to give you 500,000 Jews.

321

00:16:14,080 --> 00:16:16,050 That it's time enough to tell, OK.

322

00:16:16,050 --> 00:16:18,740 So first, send us all the children,

323

00:16:18,740 --> 00:16:21,020 then send us another category.

324

00:16:21,020 --> 00:16:23,420

But again, we never

showed in terms

325 00:16:23,420 --> 00:16:26,030 of families or selected personal friends

326 00:16:26,030 --> 00:16:30,110 and not in selecting our own families.

327 00:16:30,110 --> 00:16:31,880 It must have been really horrible

328 00:16:31,880 --> 00:16:34,520 when you didn't get the money for a while.

329 00:16:34,520 --> 00:16:36,320 No, it was more than horrible.

330 00:16:36,320 --> 00:16:38,570 That was the time really that all of us

331 00:16:38,570 --> 00:16:42,020 we have been just flabbergasted that I didn't understand

332 00:16:42,020 --> 00:16:47,750 that \$2 for one Jewish life would not be able because we

333 00:16:47,750 --> 00:16:53,330 had been thinking that the not to believe us

334 00:16:53,330 --> 00:16:55,790 was not enough argument from the other side.

335 00:16:55,790 --> 00:17:00,320 Our argument was go ahead, put the money, and give it a try

336

00:17:00,320 --> 00:17:02,040 and see why it is true.

337

00:17:02,040 --> 00:17:05,839 Then deal with it by trying it out all these children action.

338

00:17:05,839 --> 00:17:09,829 If you give us \$200,000 and if the 1,000 children come,

339

00:17:09,829 --> 00:17:12,800 then you will be able to see, yes, the whole Europa plan

340

00:17:12,800 --> 00:17:14,480 is something a reality.

341

00:17:14,480 --> 00:17:16,550 And that what makes us very angry

342

00:17:16,550 --> 00:17:20,960 that not even the smaller part of the whole plan

343

00:17:20,960 --> 00:17:24,609 was made impossible because of the bureaucracy which

344

00:17:24,609 --> 00:17:26,630 Saly Mayer represented in Switzerland.

345

00:17:26,630 --> 00:17:29,120 Because there is a very astonishing letter

346

00:17:29,120 --> 00:17:33,810 of Weissmandel which he wrote, as a matter of fact,

347 00:17:33,810 --> 00:17:39,890 much later already in the letter, I mean, in 1944.

348

00:17:39,890 --> 00:17:44,450 A was very intelligent and very answer

349

00:17:44,450 --> 00:17:48,110 is literally written in a complete Talmudic way.

350

00:17:48,110 --> 00:17:53,060 He says even if the Germans wanted to save us,

351

00:17:53,060 --> 00:17:57,950 we have to play as if they meant--

352

00:17:57,950 --> 00:18:00,920 Yeah, they meant to, that's right.

353

00:18:00,920 --> 00:18:01,580 Yes.

354

00:18:01,580 --> 00:18:04,280 And did he talk to you about this point?

355

00:18:04,280 --> 00:18:06,800 We have to act as if the German--

356

00:18:06,800 --> 00:18:08,970 Would be really doing what they promised.

357

00:18:08,970 --> 00:18:09,470

Yes.

00:18:09,470 --> 00:18:11,820 Yeah, that's right.

359

00:18:11,820 --> 00:18:12,320 All of us.

360

00:18:12,320 --> 00:18:15,050 He said so, and everybody said so that that

361

00:18:15,050 --> 00:18:18,020 is one of the reasons which was incredible to us

362

00:18:18,020 --> 00:18:20,930 that we had been willing to give it a try

363

00:18:20,930 --> 00:18:23,840 naturally because it was part of our whole activity,

364

00:18:23,840 --> 00:18:27,650 that for the crucial moment of our activity because we thought

365

00:18:27,650 --> 00:18:35,010 that if the children are really go through Switzerland,

366

00:18:35,010 --> 00:18:38,510 and even if they wouldn't be able to send to Israel,

367

00:18:38,510 --> 00:18:40,500 at least they are in Switzerland.

368

00:18:40,500 --> 00:18:42,560 And it would not be nothing, nothing wrong, 00:18:42,560 --> 00:18:45,350 so that eventually we would wait till the end

370

00:18:45,350 --> 00:18:46,520 of the war in Switzerland.

371

00:18:46,520 --> 00:18:53,120 But do you think that is a truth will be known one day?

372

00:18:53,120 --> 00:18:56,930 I mean, what do you think you personally today

373

00:18:56,930 --> 00:18:59,390 that the Germans were playing with you

374

00:18:59,390 --> 00:19:00,740 or that they were sincere?

375

00:19:00,740 --> 00:19:03,740 In that way, absolutely, we have been convinced,

376

00:19:03,740 --> 00:19:06,230 and I'm convinced now that, too, that at that point,

377

00:19:06,230 --> 00:19:08,510 the Germans were sincere.

378

00:19:08,510 --> 00:19:14,330 And just because we couldn't do what we promised,

379

00:19:14,330 --> 00:19:19,730 then the Germans started now to back up and instead

380

00:19:19,730 --> 00:19:21,770 of doing and playing

with us in connection

381 00:19:21,770 --> 00:19:25,730 with the Europa plan, started to a little bit to be lukewarm.

382

00:19:25,730 --> 00:19:29,480 And I think a few months later, Wisliency told us, too,

383

00:19:29,480 --> 00:19:33,560 that Himmler is not going to agree

384

00:19:33,560 --> 00:19:35,480 on the further negotiation of the Europa plan.

385

00:19:35,480 --> 00:19:40,790 Yeah, because there is a very strong argument against you,

386

00:19:40,790 --> 00:19:47,420 I mean, against your belief in the German's sincerity.

387

00:19:47,420 --> 00:19:50,600 It is completely true that in all the extermination

388

00:19:50,600 --> 00:19:57,080 camps, in Treblinka, Sobibor, Auschwitz, all the Jews came.

389

00:19:57,080 --> 00:19:59,810 They didn't know that they were going to die,

390

00:19:59,810 --> 00:20:04,490 and they came with money, with jewelry, with valuables,

391

00:20:04,490 --> 00:20:07,010

with dollars, with everything.

392

00:20:07,010 --> 00:20:15,680 And it is true that the people were at the entrance of the gas

393

00:20:15,680 --> 00:20:19,640 chamber, they were robbed of everything they had.

394

00:20:19,640 --> 00:20:21,590 And these extermination camps were

395

00:20:21,590 --> 00:20:26,480 absolutely full with money, with valuables, and so on.

396

00:20:26,480 --> 00:20:30,470 And it was not \$200,000, but millions and millions

397

00:20:30,470 --> 00:20:32,150 and millions of dollars.

398

00:20:32,150 --> 00:20:35,280 And why did the Germans need your money,

399

00:20:35,280 --> 00:20:38,270 the many of the Europa plan?

400

00:20:38,270 --> 00:20:39,380 Do you see the argument?

401

00:20:39,380 --> 00:20:44,450 I see the argument, too, but I would say German,

402

00:20:44,450 --> 00:20:48,530 Germany at that time was really in a little bit harder

00:20:48,530 --> 00:20:50,600 pressed for many other places.

404

00:20:50,600 --> 00:20:55,820 And very possibly, that that's time to buy certain goods,

405

00:20:55,820 --> 00:20:57,950 they needed dollars.

406

00:20:57,950 --> 00:20:59,720 And interesting enough, you remember

407

00:20:59,720 --> 00:21:02,990 that later on after the Europa plan was transferred

408

00:21:02,990 --> 00:21:06,020 from Slovakia to Hungary, even the Germans

409

00:21:06,020 --> 00:21:09,500 changed the conditions from the Europa plan.

410

00:21:09,500 --> 00:21:13,310 And instead of money, they asked different goods.

411

00:21:13,310 --> 00:21:14,430 Yes, but you cannot--

412

00:21:14,430 --> 00:21:16,240 but this Europa plan at the time,

413

00:21:16,240 --> 00:21:20,530 because the question was only to rescue the Hungarian Jew.

414

00:21:20,530 --> 00:21:24,160

No, it was it was still with us because you remember Wisliency,

415 00:21:24,160 --> 00:21:27,520 after he left Slovakia went to Greece.

416 00:21:27,520 --> 00:21:30,350 But immediately, every month, once he came back,

417 00:21:30,350 --> 00:21:32,550 and we had a meeting, Gisi Fleischmann and myself,

418 00:21:32,550 --> 00:21:33,710 met Wisliency.

419 00:21:33,710 --> 00:21:38,620 And we constantly kept him asking that we should not

420 00:21:38,620 --> 00:21:41,080 forget about the Europa plan.

421 00:21:41,080 --> 00:21:44,017 Wisliency went to Greece in order to organize--

422 00:21:44,017 --> 00:21:45,100 Organize and deportations.

423 00:21:45,100 --> 00:21:46,240 And deportations of Jews.

424 00:21:46,240 --> 00:21:46,910 That's right.

425 00:21:46,910 --> 00:21:49,210 To ship them to Auschwitz.

426 00:21:49,210 --> 00:21:51,730 That's right.

427 00:21:51,730 --> 00:21:55,450 How could you go and negotiating with Wisliency

428 00:21:55,450 --> 00:22:00,250 when you saw the transport of Greek Jews

429 00:22:00,250 --> 00:22:04,870 passing Slovakia, as a matter of fact, because it was a way.

430 00:22:04,870 --> 00:22:07,720 How could you believe in Wisliency

431 00:22:07,720 --> 00:22:11,740 when you saw in the same times as the deportations were

432 00:22:11,740 --> 00:22:13,120 going on?

433 00:22:13,120 --> 00:22:15,790 No, that from the Greek deportation

434 00:22:15,790 --> 00:22:19,600 was, for us, a question mark. we still

435 00:22:19,600 --> 00:22:22,120 didn't understand why it happened that way.

436 00:22:22,120 --> 00:22:23,020 Wisliency--

437 00:22:23,020 --> 00:22:27,860 438 00:22:27,860 --> 00:22:30,290 (film slating)

439 00:22:30,290 --> 00:22:32,690 I guess, my question is, how could you

440 00:22:32,690 --> 00:22:36,440 go on believing in the sincerity of Wisliency

441 00:22:36,440 --> 00:22:46,040 because Wisliency left Slovakia for Greece in February 1943.

442 00:22:46,040 --> 00:22:50,300 And he was a organizer with the deportations of Greek Jews

443 00:22:50,300 --> 00:22:53,510 from Thessaloniki.

444 00:22:53,510 --> 00:22:56,330 And they were all shipped to Auschwitz.

445 00:22:56,330 --> 00:23:00,350 And you say that Wisliency was coming

446 00:23:00,350 --> 00:23:04,520 back every month from Greece to Slovakia

447 00:23:04,520 --> 00:23:07,823 on the transport of the Greek Jews.

448 00:23:07,823 --> 00:23:09,240 As a matter of fact, had to pass-- 00:23:09,240 --> 00:23:10,157 Went through Slovakia.

450

00:23:10,157 --> 00:23:11,270 --through Slovakia.

451 $00:23:11,270 \longrightarrow 00:23:13,850$ This means that you witnessed this.

452 00:23:13,850 --> 00:23:18,800 How could you go on believing in the sincerity of this man?

453 $00:23:18,800 \longrightarrow 00:23:24,530$ Now, that for the following, after in Greece,

454 00:23:24,530 --> 00:23:27,230 we didn't have direct connection neither to the Zionist,

455 $00:23:27,230 \longrightarrow 00:23:29,480$ neither to the orthodoxy.

456 00:23:29,480 --> 00:23:34,520 So we ask Wisliency that the moment he comes to Greece he

457 00:23:34,520 --> 00:23:36,980 should get now and find out who are

458 00:23:36,980 --> 00:23:38,810 the leaders of the Zionists, who are

459 00:23:38,810 --> 00:23:40,610 the leaders of the assimilated Jews,

460 $00:23:40,610 \longrightarrow 00:23:42,485$ and who are the leaders

of the Orthodox Jews.

461 00:23:42,485 --> 00:23:43,068 You asked him.

462 00:23:43,068 --> 00:23:44,060 We asked him, sure.

463 00:23:44,060 --> 00:23:46,010 But you were in a very close relationship.

464 00:23:46,010 --> 00:23:47,510 That time, in a very close relation.

465 00:23:47,510 --> 00:23:50,570 We have been speaking with Wisliency, both of us,

466 00:23:50,570 --> 00:23:53,880 Gisi Fleischmann and myself, just like in the same way

467 00:23:53,880 --> 00:23:56,220 as I'm speaking now with you.

468 00:23:56,220 --> 00:23:57,482 Unbelievable.

469 00:23:57,482 --> 00:24:00,620 And he came back, and we ask him that.

470 00:24:00,620 --> 00:24:01,640 What happened?

471 00:24:01,640 --> 00:24:04,580 Why couldn't you do the same thing what we did here

472 00:24:04,580 --> 00:24:07,010 473

00:24:07,010 --> 00:24:10,610 And Wisliency's answer all time, you cannot compare

474

00:24:10,610 --> 00:24:13,010 the situation with Greece.

475

00:24:13,010 --> 00:24:16,280 And he made us believe that he had

476

00:24:16,280 --> 00:24:19,440 so strict orders and the man somebody

477

00:24:19,440 --> 00:24:21,200 was there on top of him.

478

00:24:21,200 --> 00:24:22,730 He was in Slovakia.

479

00:24:22,730 --> 00:24:27,140 He was the only [INAUDIBLE] for the Jewish question

480

00:24:27,140 --> 00:24:29,060 on the German side.

481

00:24:29,060 --> 00:24:34,460 But in Greece, he had, as he told us, two others.

482

00:24:34,460 --> 00:24:36,320 And he told us that he absolutely

483

00:24:36,320 --> 00:24:39,500 couldn't make any contact with the Jewish leadership

484

00:24:39,500 --> 00:24:41,270 in Greece.

485

00:24:41,270 --> 00:24:46,190 That is for us a question mark all the time it was why.

486

00:24:46,190 --> 00:24:49,100 He never gave us the answer, and we never found out,

487

00:24:49,100 --> 00:24:51,020 not even after the war.

488

00:24:51,020 --> 00:24:51,895 But his credibility--

489

00:24:51,895 --> 00:24:55,910 But the credibility, granted, the idea

490

00:24:55,910 --> 00:24:57,620 was following saying we have a feeling

491

00:24:57,620 --> 00:25:02,960 that the credibility from our side was not that good neither.

492

00:25:02,960 --> 00:25:07,110 We didn't with any of our promises to them.

493

00:25:07,110 --> 00:25:09,440 And that's why we took that.

494

00:25:09,440 --> 00:25:12,770 We said all the time, even if that happened in Greece,

495

00:25:12,770 --> 00:25:16,370 we still would like to save if we are not able to save Greece.

496 00:25:16,370 --> 00:25:20,180 So there are still others here who should be saved,

497 00:25:20,180 --> 00:25:22,520 and we cannot give up just because in Greece it

498 00:25:22,520 --> 00:25:23,780 didn't work.

499 00:25:23,780 --> 00:25:26,600 So that's why, for instance, even Weissmandel ask me,

500 00:25:26,600 --> 00:25:30,470 I remember now, to tell Wisliency

501 00:25:30,470 --> 00:25:32,960 that his credibility was very much hurt

502 00:25:32,960 --> 00:25:38,480 and the word Jew is going to put that in a black mark for him

503 00:25:38,480 --> 00:25:41,510 because he did deportation in spite of in the same time

504 00:25:41,510 --> 00:25:45,350 that we started to negotiate with him for the Europa plan.

505 00:25:45,350 --> 00:25:47,480 But that was all.

506 00:25:47,480 --> 00:25:51,230 And interesting enough, really, I just 507 00:25:51,230 --> 00:25:54,680 don't understand why we couldn't make any contact with not

508 00:25:54,680 --> 00:25:57,080 even the Jewish people there.

509 00:25:57,080 --> 00:25:59,420 Weissmandel himself had no contacts with him in Greece.

510 00:25:59,420 --> 00:26:00,860 No, we had--

511 00:26:00,860 --> 00:26:01,880 Weissmandel personally?

512 00:26:01,880 --> 00:26:04,190 No, personally, he didn't.

513 00:26:04,190 --> 00:26:05,420 But the contact--

514 00:26:05,420 --> 00:26:09,710 I would say I was Weissmandel's sprecher as you called it.

515 00:26:09,710 --> 00:26:12,680 I was the guy who spoke what Weissmandel

516 00:26:12,680 --> 00:26:16,400 told me to say to Wisliency.

517 00:26:16,400 --> 00:26:20,090 And Wisliency knew that Rabbi Weissmandel

518 00:26:20,090 --> 00:26:22,100 exist because I very, very openly 519

00:26:22,100 --> 00:26:26,660 and frankly told him that who are the members of the work

520

00:26:26,660 --> 00:26:28,460 camp.

521

00:26:28,460 --> 00:26:29,360 All right.

522

00:26:29,360 --> 00:26:31,790 And now, I would like to come to another point

523

00:26:31,790 --> 00:26:35,600 and to ask you what is your feeling about this.

524

00:26:35,600 --> 00:26:41,930 In September 1944, when the deportations from Slovakia

525

00:26:41,930 --> 00:26:48,440 were resumed and started again, Weissmandel himself

526

00:26:48,440 --> 00:26:53,840 was shipped to Auschwitz with his family, with his wife

527

00:26:53,840 --> 00:26:55,230 and with the children.

528

00:26:55,230 --> 00:26:56,210 That's right.

529

00:26:56,210 --> 00:27:00,185 And you know that he escaped from the train.

530

00:27:00,185 --> 00:27:01,685 Yeah, he jumped from the train.

531 00:27:01,685 --> 00:27:02,330 He jumped.

532

00:27:02,330 --> 00:27:03,800 He escaped alone.

533

00:27:03,800 --> 00:27:04,970 He left the--

534

00:27:04,970 --> 00:27:05,600 Family.

535

00:27:05,600 --> 00:27:09,150 -- the family into the train.

536

00:27:09,150 --> 00:27:13,310 And he was very disturbed after while according

537

00:27:13,310 --> 00:27:15,410 to all the testimonies we have.

538

00:27:15,410 --> 00:27:17,050 He called himself a murderer--

539

00:27:17,050 --> 00:27:21,320 Murderer and traitor of the family, that's right.

540

00:27:21,320 --> 00:27:22,550 How do you explain this?

541

00:27:22,550 --> 00:27:25,070 What is your feeling about?

542

00:27:25,070 --> 00:27:27,080 You know, at that

time, I was already

543

00:27:27,080 --> 00:27:30,320

in the so-called partisan land for Slovakia

544

00:27:30,320 --> 00:27:33,230 which was so that I heard all this only

545

00:27:33,230 --> 00:27:35,240 after the liberation came.

546

00:27:35,240 --> 00:27:38,240 And I heard it just exactly what you

547

00:27:38,240 --> 00:27:42,080 said that Weissmandel was sent first to Sered and from Sered

548

00:27:42,080 --> 00:27:45,248 he was sent to Auschwitz.

549

00:27:45,248 --> 00:27:46,040 Concentration camp.

550

00:27:46,040 --> 00:27:46,910 Concentration camp.

551

00:27:46,910 --> 00:27:49,580 Sered, and from there, he was deported to Auschwitz.

552

00:27:49,580 --> 00:27:51,800 And he jumped from the train, and he

553

00:27:51,800 --> 00:27:57,390 was very disturbed state of mind and cried constantly.

554

00:27:57,390 --> 00:28:00,530 And this mea culpa was constantly here 555

00:28:00,530 --> 00:28:04,700 that he considered himself the murder of his family.

556 00:28:04,700 --> 00:28:08,870 But we thought that he did right.

557 00:28:08,870 --> 00:28:11,480

558 00:28:11,480 --> 00:28:15,380 We knew that only one person who jumped the train

559 00:28:15,380 --> 00:28:20,750 could eventually save himself and go slowly through and go

560 00:28:20,750 --> 00:28:23,330 back again to a place where he felt safe.

561 00:28:23,330 --> 00:28:26,190 But we knew that if the family--

562 00:28:26,190 --> 00:28:27,920 these are family, you cannot do it.

563 00:28:27,920 --> 00:28:31,550 And Weissmandel was such an exceptional part

564 00:28:31,550 --> 00:28:34,580 of this whole Rettungsaktion action, which are still going

565 00:28:34,580 --> 00:28:40,250 on, that we thought that his--

566 00:28:40,250 --> 00:28:45,170 I would say messianic--

567 00:28:45,170 --> 00:28:45,920 Mission.

568

00:28:45,920 --> 00:28:46,790 Yeah, that's right.

569

00:28:46,790 --> 00:28:49,730 Mission was so big that made him even

570

00:28:49,730 --> 00:28:54,800 to leave this family to go back again and try to be helpful

571

00:28:54,800 --> 00:28:56,250 as much as possible.

572

00:28:56,250 --> 00:28:57,170 This is your feeling?

573

00:28:57,170 --> 00:28:59,990 That was my feeling that I understood that he did it

574

00:28:59,990 --> 00:29:04,800 because truth of the matter is I would have done the same thing.

575

00:29:04,800 --> 00:29:06,440 Don't forget one thing.

576

00:29:06,440 --> 00:29:12,020 That in this work group, all of us we didn't speak about,

577

00:29:12,020 --> 00:29:14,420 we didn't insult too much about the families.

578

00:29:14,420 --> 00:29:18,140

We really somehow, we had been transformed for some,

579 00:29:18,140 --> 00:29:23,150 I don't know all, that we are here to save other people.

580 00:29:23,150 --> 00:29:26,760 We are here to be able to organize something

581 00:29:26,760 --> 00:29:28,160 to other people.

582 00:29:28,160 --> 00:29:31,678 Unknown people should be saved, not we and our families.

583 00:29:31,678 --> 00:29:33,470 As a matter of fact, it is very interesting

584 00:29:33,470 --> 00:29:37,550 because to come back to what we said about the Hungarian Jews,

585 00:29:37,550 --> 00:29:39,840 they saved their families.

586 00:29:39,840 --> 00:29:43,063 And Weissmandel didn't care about his own family.

587 00:29:43,063 --> 00:29:44,730 Yeah, no, but you see, that's the reason

588 00:29:44,730 --> 00:29:48,290 why I understood why Weissmandel did it this way.

589 00:29:48,290 --> 00:29:51,140 And I was told that a lot of people who tried

590 00:29:51,140 --> 00:29:53,570 to help him with that difficult time

591 00:29:53,570 --> 00:29:56,480 that he should not consider him as a traitor, just a contrary.

592 00:29:56,480 --> 00:30:00,110 That his mission was to be alive and not to try now

593 00:30:00,110 --> 00:30:02,780 to do something what was impossible.

594 00:30:02,780 --> 00:30:04,670 So we considered his action and he

595 00:30:04,670 --> 00:30:08,960 is doing that as something the right thing to do.

596 00:30:08,960 --> 00:30:10,940 OK.

597 00:30:10,940 --> 00:30:13,100 Now, I come to another point, and I

598 00:30:13,100 --> 00:30:16,460 would like to have you're feeling, too, about this.

599 00:30:16,460 --> 00:30:20,060

600 00:30:20,060 --> 00:30:22,850 I made an interview for this film 601 00:30:22,850 --> 00:30:33,260 with Rudolf Vrba who escaped Auschwitz 7th of April 1944.

602 00:30:33,260 --> 00:30:37,280 And who arrived in Slovakia on the 21 of April,
