Scope and content note: The papers consist of ration cards, a passport, a newspaper clipping, correspondence, and other documents relating to Niels Bamberger's escape from Denmark to Sweden during World War II.

Inventory

1. Ration card from Denmark enabling one to obtain clothing and shoes, 1944 April.
2. Ration card enabling one to obtain butter, 1947 April.
3. Ration card enabling one to obtain tobacco, 1945 Oct.
4. Passport, a child's passport made in Denmark at the German embassy, 1941 Aug. 7.
5. Danish passport documenting every time he left the country or exchanged money, 1959 Apr. 4.
6. Resistance saying, "The Germans are not wanted here," 1940-1941.

7. Swedish newspaper article of graduation of Danish school in Lund in Sweden, 1945.
8. Letters, sent to Mr. Bamberger which were censored by the government, 1944 Dec. 26.
9. Card, from the Bamberger's restaurant in Sweden, 1943 Oct.
10. Envelope, mailed from Sweden to Denmark, with a seal from the censors, 1945 June.
