Scope and content note: The collection consists of photographs, taken at Buchenwald at the time of liberation, that show camp structures, crematoria, corpses, and liberated prisoners. The photographs were taken by Harry L. Smith in April 1945 when he was a medic with the 628th Medical Clearing Company of the U.S. First Army.

- 1. 1 copyprint: b&w. Corpses, one body in the foreground and a pile of bodies in the background, 1945.
- 2. 1 copyprint: b&w. Corpses, large pile of corpses stacked parallel to the picture frame, 1945.
- 3. 1 copyprint: b&w. Copyprint of a vehicle with corpses piled on it, 1945.
- 4. 1 copyprint: b&w. Copyprint of men walking (in the direction of the right side of the picture), 1945.
- 5. 1 copyprint: b&w. Copyprint of men gathered together. Men stand in the center of the picture. There is a car and a building on the left side of the picture, 1945.

- 10. 1 copyprint: b&w. Copyprint of six men. They stand in front of a wooden structure, 1945.
- 11. 1 copyprint: b&w. Copyprint of two men with a third man partially visible between the two. They stand in front of a wooden structure.
- 12. 1 copyprint: b&w. Copyprint of three young men wearing loose clothing. The one at the left wears a hat.
- 13. 1 copyprint: b&w. Copyprint of men apparently sorting through a long line of hay. The interior fence and watchtower of the camp are visible.
- 14. 1 copyprint: b&w. Copyprint of a man in dark clothing standing in front of a building.
- 15. 1 copyprint: b&w. Copyprint of a man in a camp uniform.
- 16. 1 copyprint: b&w. Copyprint of a man in a camp uniform holding what is possibly a mounted tattoo.
