**Scope and content note:** The papers consist of a civil marriage certificate issued in Berchem, Belgium, for Osias Zupnik and Chana Beila Klein, a photograph of Leon Zupnik [donor's brother], a certificate of residence from Lille, France for Leon Zupnik, and a certificate documenting Leon Zupnik's arrest and deportation to Auschwitz.

## Inventory

- 1. Civil marriage certificate, Berchem (province of Antwerp), 1927 May 24. Certifies that Osias Zupnik and Chana Beila Klein have been married. Following page lists the names of their children (Leon and Helene).
- 2. Certificate, Paris, 1950 Mar. 14. Certificate which states that Leon Zupnik was arrested in Lille in 1942, transferred first to Malines (Belgium) and then to Auschwitz. Nothing has been heard of him since. Issued by the Ministry of War Veterans and Victims of War.
- 3. Certificate of residence, Lille, 1958. Certificate which states that Leon Zupnik resided in Likke from May 20, 1940, until he was arrested by the Germans in 1942. Issued by the Ministry of the Interior and stamped with the seal of the Chief of Police, Lille.
