## **Elizabeth Trausel Family Collection Inventory**

- 1. Postcard sent Elisabeth Trausel to her daughter, Eva Trausel, Theresienstadt, April 1945.
- 2. Certificate regarding sending food packages sent to Berta Deutsch, a relative of the Trausel family, in the Łódź ghetto, 1943. Berta Deutsch did not survive the Holocaust.
- 3. Postcard sent to Elisabeth Trausel in Prague from Dr. Irwin Pick, a relative in the Theresienstadt ghetto, March 16, 1944. Dr. Irwin Pick did not survive the Holocaust.
- 4. Postcard sent to Elisabeth Trausel in Prague from Berta Kassler, a relative in the Theresienstadt ghetto, October 19, 1943.
- 5. Postcard sent to Elisabeth Trausel from Hedwig Pick, a relative in the Theresienstadt ghetto, August 1944. Hedwig Pick did not survive the Holocaust.
- 6. Postcard sent to Elisabeth Trausel from Leo Polacek, a relative in the Theresienstadt ghetto, October 5, 1944.
- 7. Postcard addressed to Josef Polacek, Elisabeth Trausel's father, from Berta Deutsch, October 1944. Dr. Josef Polacek in Prague had, in the meantime, committed suicide, while refusing to join a transport East.
