Below are translations of some of the transcriptions in the album.

First page recto: "The Engagement of the/62. Inf. Regt./in/Austria!/on 10.III.1938. [March 10, 1938]/  
Regiment Commander:/Colonel Lang/Commander of the 3. Battalion:/Lt. Colonel Amann [Mann?]"

First page verso: "Loading a barge on 12 March/Infantry 'march' into Austria. Donauhafen, Passau"

Second page recto: "'The sons of our land, our soldiers [sic] have substantially contributed to that end  
one of the greatest historic deeds in our history.'/Adolf Hitler/on 2.IV.1938. [April 2, 1938]"

Second page verso: "Loading of horses on a barge/Donauhafen in Passau. 13, March"

Third page recto: "Our march route! 3. Battalion/under leadership/of/Lt. Colonel Amann/rule  
1:600,000"

Third page verso: "Mobilization on 12 & 13 March./Arrival of the 20th IR. [infantry reg.] v. Deggendorf  
ET in Passau"

Fourth page recto: "War preparation in the summer barracks [sic] Passau/11, III, 38/building an  
SMG/mobilization on Friday, 11 March Passau E I."
