Inventory of the Weiss Family Papers

1. Document sent from Malines, France by Karl Weiss to Madame Dujardin, containing a checklist of items, preprinted and inscribed in black ink, March 19, 1943; in French. Madame Dujardin saved Dorothea and her sister from deportation by the Gestapo.
2. "Führungszeugnis," a good conduct certificate, issued to Berta Weiss in Berlin, Germany, September 12, 1938; in German. Includes two circular blue ink stamps from the "Polizeipräsident in Berlin."
3. Letter sent to Karl Weiss from the Police in Berlin, Germany, December 17, 1934; in German.
4. Birth certificate reissued to a Jewish man, Nr. 3531, in Berlin, Germany, August 13, 1926; in German.
