14. **Document**; order to go to Labor Camp issued to Salomon Hudes (Ziggy's father) issued by the Arbeidsambt Antwerpen (Labor Department in Antwerp); preprinted form in black ink with handwritten entries in black ink, black ink stamp in upper left corner; dated July 30, 1942; Antwerp, Belgium; in Flemish
 15. **Copy document**; reverse copy of document issued to "Salomon Hudes" (Ziggy's father); typed; original dated October 14, 1949; Antwerp, Belgium; in Flemish
 16. **Marriage Certificate**; "Heiratsurkunde"; preprinted form in black ink with typed entries in black ink; re-issued for marriage of "Salomon Hudes" (Ziggy's father) and "Hanna Hudes" (Ziggy's mother); dated December 22, 1958; Dortmund, Germany; in German
 17. **Photographic print**; black and white image of three priests wearing robes, walking together outside; verso: black and blue ink inscriptions, piece of pink paper with black print adhered; in Flemish; pictured from left: Bishop and Pastor who helped hide Ziggy Hudes during war
 18. **Copy print**; black and white image of older man wearing coat and hat being escorted by the arm by man wearing suit and tie; dated 1985; Antwerp, Belgium; pictured: Ziggy Hudes and the Pastor
