Printed in black ink on recto: "Boycot alle zaken en ontspan-/ningslokalen die Juden weren/Toont date Moed en Solidariteit/onder de Hollandse arbeiders leven/Kameraden,/legt het werk in jullie bedrijven neer bij/elke nieuwe uitbarsting van anti-Joodse/beestachtigheid/Het Derde Front"; printed in two different fonts; verso: graphite inscription "2 vitvine/Printed/W...D..dde.."; dated circa 1941; in German and Dutch.
4. Document printed by the Communist resistance again persecution of Jews, circa 1941. Printed in black ink: "De vrijheid/van de Duitse en Hollandse nazi's [sic] wil zeggen:/kneveling, mishandeling en arrestaties van Joodse/medeburgers Kiest de partij der zwakken tegen de sterken/Elk geweld moet met staking/beantwoord worden!/Het Derde Front"; dated circa 1941, in Dutch.

6. Identification card for Sophia Mendels, issued on April 7, 1944, in Amsterdam, Holland. "Persoonsbewijs"; printed in purple ink, paper has lavender printed background; recto: black ink "J" stamped in upper right corner, black and white photograph of bearer affixed on left side with second black ink "J" stamped to left of photo, black ink signature above; verso: Nr. A35 / No.686699 printed three times across top; typed black entries, issued to "Sophia Mendels" born August 16, 1911 in Amsterdam, two black ink fingerprints, print on right adhered with gray border; issued April 7, 1944; Amsterdam, Holland; in Dutch.
7. Identification card for Sophia Mendels, issued on August 28, 1941, in Amsterdam, Holland. "Persoonsbewijs"; printed in purple ink, paper has lavender printed background; recto: black ink "J" stamped in upper right corner, black ink stamp in center above circular black ink stamp with image of Nazi eagle and swastika, signature and second black ink "J" in center, black and white photograph of bearer affixed on left side with third and fourth black ink "J" stamped to left and right of photo, black ink signature above; verso: Nr. A35 / No. 593511 printed three

- times across top; typed black entries, issued to "Sophia Mendels" born August 16, 1911 in Amsterdam, two black ink fingerprints, print on right adhered with red border; issued August 28, 1941; Amsterdam, Holland; in Dutch.
8. Identification card for Sophia Mendels, issued on November 24, 1943, in Amsterdam, Holland. "Persoonsbewijs"; printed in purple ink, paper has lavender printed background; recto: red ink "J" stamped in upper right corner, black and white photograph of bearer affixed on left side with second red ink "J" stamped to left of photo, black ink signature above; verso: Nr. A35 / No. 675212 printed three times across top; typed black entries, issued to "Sophia Mendels" born August 16, 1911 in Amsterdam, two black ink fingerprints, print on right adhered with blue border; issued November 24, 1943; Amsterdam, Holland; in Dutch.
 9. Forged Identification card for Sophia Mendels, issued in July 8, 1941, Amsterdam, Holland. "Persoonsbewijs"; printed in purple ink, paper has lavender printed background; recto: "ongeld.." stamped in black ink diagonally in center; black and white photograph of bearer affixed on left side, black ink signature above; verso: Nr. A35 / No. 226003 printed three times across top; typed black entries, issued to "Sophia Mendels" born August 16, 1911 in Amsterdam, two black ink fingerprints, print on right adhered with red border, "ongeldig" stamped in black ink diagonally across side three times; issued July 8, 1941; Amsterdam, Holland; in Dutch.
 10. Newspaper; "Het Joodsche Weekblad," headline reads "Extra Editie/De Duitse autoriteiten maken bekend:..." lists three points; dated August 7, 1942; Amsterdam, Holland; in Dutch.
 11. Newspaper; "Het Joodsche Weekblad," headlines read: "Van den Joodschen Raad," "Zitverbod op banken te Den Haag," "Joodschemarkten en groenteverkoop op de a.s. Hooge Feestdagen" and "Teka' besjofar gadol;" dated September 11, 1942; Amsterdam, Holland; in Dutch.
 12. Document; banner for "Het Joodsche Weekblad" across top; printed in black ink below banner "Extra Editie/Amsterdam. 14. Juli 1942/De sicherheitspolizei deelt ons het vol-/gende mede:/Ongeveer 700 Joden zijn heden te Amster-/dam gearresteerd. Als deze week niet de/4000 daartoe aangewezen Joden naar de/werkkampen in Duitschland vertrekken,/ zullen de 700 arrestanten naar een con-/centratiekamp in Duitschland worden over-/gebracht./De voorzitters van den/Joodschen Raad voor Amsterdam,/A. Asscher/Prof. Dr. D. Cohen"; dated July 14, 1942; Amsterdam, Holland; in Dutch.

Document; "Aanmeldingsformulier/voor één persoon"; declaration of Jewish origin; preprinted form in black ink with blue ink stamp "Amersfoort"; at entries #13 and at bottom recto; verso: "Toelichting" text printed in black ink, blue circular ink stamp "Rijksinstituut voor Oorlogsdocumentatie" in lower right corner; dated 1941; in German and Dutch.
