Phyllis Milstein Collection Inventory

1. Translation; "Affidavit of Birth"; original document issued for Oskar Frankiel, serving in place of a birth certificate, states that he was deported into Buchenwald Concentration Camp and all of his documents including his birth certificate were taken away. The document also states that he was repeatedly written to the Registrar's offices in Czenstochow, Poland and asked for a new Birth Certificate but has never received a reply. Original document dated February 6, 1950, Celle, Germany; in English and German.
2. Photographic Rosh Hashana card, a photograph of the Frankiel family, with a message written in Hebrew characters printed in blue ink, signed "Family Frankiel/Bergen-Belsen, Tishrei 5708," Bergen-Belsen displaced persons camp, Germany, September 1947; in Yiddish.
3. Photograph of the wedding of Hannah and Bernard Weinstock (Phyllis Milstein's aunt and her husband), an unidentified woman, two unidentified men, and Phyllis Milstein standing on left, Bergen-Belsen displaced persons camp, Germany, undated.
4. Photographic of Phyllis Milstein's tenth birthday party. Phyllis Milstein stands in the center holding flowers while a man pours contents of a bottle into a glass, undated.
5. Photographic postcard of a group of girls at the Bergen-Belsen displaced persons camp, Germany, undated. Phyllis Milstein is standing in the second row in the center directly behind the girl seated second from right. Verso: red ink stamp "Foto K [inverted triangle] Z/Sch. Krotmann & M. Kieffer/Bergen-Belsen/Block 45. Zimmer 31" printed in square.
6. Photograph of a group of seven men and women standing together in row outside, three children standing in front of them on left side, Bergen-Belsen displaced persons camp, Germany, undated.
