1. **Referral**; written by head of electrical workshops in the Łódź ghetto (Elektrizitäts Abteilung) recommending Symcha Kopelman, policeman #419, residing on 5 Lwowska Street for work in servicing streetcars, who qualifies since he is an electrician; the referral is addressed to Engineer Dawidowicz; blue ink stamp: Der Aelteste der Juden in Litzmanstadt, Elektrizitäts Abteilung; dated: September 17, 1941; location: Łódź ghetto, Poland; in Polish and German
2. **Photographic print**; black and white image of portrait of young woman wearing hat and holding mandolin (Hanka Kopelman who perished in the Łódź ghetto); verso: blue ink stamp of photographer; dated: April 1934; location: Łódź, Poland
3. **Photographic print**; black and white image of portrait of man in suit and tie, wearing hat (Symcha Binem Kopelman); dated: c. 1939; location: Piotrków Trybunalski, Poland
4. **Photographic print**; black and white image of group of Hassidic Jews standing inside (first on right is the Gere Rebe; man in fur hat is Rebe's son: Symche Binem Alter; man standing on left is Abram Mordche Kopelman, Symcha Binem Kopelman's father); verso: blue ink inscription; location: Poland; in Yiddish
5. **Photographic postcard**; black and white image of woman in white dress walking alongside man in dark shirt (Blanka Gruenbaum and Symcha Binem Kopelman); dated: c.1939; location: Łódź, Poland

21. **Photographic postcard;** black and white image of young woman wearing white sleeveless sport dress and shoes leaning on doorway (Hela Sieracka Kopelman); two signs on both sides of door: sign on left: " Breakfasts, Lunches, Dinners, Milk, Buttermilk, white and black Coffee, Tea, Chocolate, Pastry; sign on right: " Lemonade, Soda, Ice-cream, Wine, Bear and Honey; dart board affixed to door; location: Poland; in Polish
22. **Photographic postcard;** black and white image of two young men and two young women (on left: Pinkus Kopelman, Symcha Binem Kopelman's brother and his cousin, Heniek Eibuszyc with his wife and sister); verso: black ink stamp with name of photographer; location: Poland
23. **Photographic postcard;** black and white image of small girl in dark dress, with bow in hair, holding flowers, wearing dark shoes and white socks; verso; black ink inscription: " Dear Zosia, I received your letter and I am answering right away; about Mania: if you'll write to her, she will answer; please send me your photograph; no more news, yours Sabina"; Sender: Sabina Zigler in Piotrków Trybunalski, sent to Zosia Dzialowska in Łódź; location: Piotrków Trybunalski, Poland; in Polish
24. **Photographic print;** black and white image of man, woman and four children, seated at table (seated from left: Sonia Kniker, Renia's mother; Romek Kniker, Renia's brother; Regina Renia Kniker; Dasza Kniker, Renia's sister; Leon Kniker, Renia's brother and Emanuel Kniker, Renia's father); verso: sticker with preprinted numbers affixed; dated: c. 1930; location: Łódź, Poland
