Document; "Ausweiskarte" preprinted form in black ink with typed black ink entries; issued to Daniel Dresden (Eline's father); Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in German

Document; preprinted in black ink with handwritten graphite entries; issued to "Dresden, Eline"; Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in German

Document; preprinted in black ink with typed black ink entries; issued to Eline Dresden; dated February 3, 1943; Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in German

Document; "Lager Westerbork Arbeitskarte" preprinted in black ink on blue paper with typed black ink entries; issued to E. Dresden ; issued October 4, 1943; Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in German and Flemish

Document; "Alarm-Ausweis" preprinted in black ink with typed black ink entries; issued to Daniel Dresden (Eline's father); dated May 2, 1944; Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in German

Document; "Ausweis" preprinted in black ink with handwritten ink entries; issued to Eline Dresden; dated January 1944; Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in German

Document; "Abends Brei" typed in black ink with handwritten black ink entries; issued to Eline Dresden; dated April 15, 1944; Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in German

Document; handwritten in black ink; issued to Eline Dresden , lists three items below name; verso: "Magazin-Lagerkrankenhaus" stamped in blue ink with stamped signature; in German

Identity Card; preprinted in black ink with typed black ink entries; issued to “Prof. Ir. Daniel Dresden” (Eline’s father) by the Canadian military; issued May 26, 1945; allows him to travel to and from the camp; Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in German, English, and Flemish

Document; preprinted in black ink with handwritten black ink entries; issued to E. Dresden; dated December 2, 1943; Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in German

Document; typed black ink with graphite signature; issued to Eline Dresden; dated February 14, 1944; Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in German

Document; preprinted in black ink with typed black carbon ink entries; issued to Daniel Dresden (Eline’s father); issued May 17, 1945; Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in Flemish

Document; “Arbeitskarte” preprinted in black ink with typed black ink entries; issued to Eline Dresden; issued October 5, 1944; Westerbork transit camp, The Netherlands; in German
