1. Photograph of Renee Schwalb posing outdoors with a lake or a river, while on a visit to her mother, from the convent where she was hiding, Belgium, circa 1940-1943.
2. Photograph of Renee Schwalb with the mother and daughter of the family with whom she was hiding during the war, walking down a street, Belgium, circa 1942-1944. The daughter's name was Jeannie. The mother's name and family's surname is unknown.
3. Photograph of Renee Schwalb (right), Sima Schwalb, and Renee's cousin, while Renee was on a visit to her mother from hiding, Belgium, 1943.
4. Photograph of Renee Schwalb and her mother, Sima Schwalb, after liberation, Belgium, 1945. Renee Schwalb survived in hiding, and Sima Schwalb survived the concentration camps, including Auschwitz-Birkenau.
5. Photograph of Renee Schwalb (right) and an unidentified girl posing outdoors in a botanical garden, holding dolls, Brussels, Belgium, 1945.
