Eugene Berger Collection Inventory

1. Photograph of people standing, looking at pile of partially clothed corpses laying on the ground in the Buchenwald concentration camp, Buchenwald, Germany, April 1945.
2. Photograph of men and women standing next to gallows, soldiers looking over a wooden fence behind them in Buchenwald concentration camp, Buchenwald, Germany, circa 1945. Verso inscribed in French: "MISE AU POINT/Les civils de Weimer on/été forcés de visiter le c/de Buchenwald dans toute s/horreur pour constater la/sauvagerie nazie./PHOTO-FRANCE A.E.P."
3. Identification card, D.P. Identification Card, #303793 issued to "Berger Eugen" [sic], printed in red ink with entries handwritten in black ink, thumb print on right side, instructions printed on verso; issued May 27, 1946; Lampertheim, Germany; in English and German.
4. Identification card, "Displaced Persons/Assembly Center 578/Lampertheim/Identity-Card" issued to "Berger Eugen" [sic], torn down center fold, printed in black ink with handwritten entries in black ink; states that he was a prisoner in Auschwitz; black and white photograph of bearer affixed to right piece; issued April 29, 1946; Lampertheim, Germany; in English.
