Helen Zimm Photograph Collection Inventory

1. Photograph of an ORT class, with five men seated at a table writing, two men standing behind them, and a third man on the left, Berlin, Germany, circa 1946-1948. The man standing on the far right is Bolek Jezinski.
2. Photograph of Helen Zimm, wearing a print dress and leaning on her folded arms, with five other women looking out an open window, Berlin, Germany, 1946. Inscribed "Berlin Schlachtensee" and "1946" and "144."
3. Photograph of a group of men and women gathered together, Berlin, Germany, 1946. Helen Zimm is seated in the front row on the far right with her legs crossed and hands in her lap. Inscribed in German: "Berlin/1946" and "Nojding-Lederman/Fotografen/Berlin-Schlachtensee/UNNRA-Lager."
4. Photograph of a group of men and women gathered together, Berlin, Germany, July 25, 1947. Inscribed in Polish. Helen Zimm is standing on the far right. Zimm worked with the people pictured in the clothing area run by the Joint Distribution Committee.
5. Photograph of Helen Zimm at a wedding in Berlin Schlachtensee, Berlin, Germany, 1947. Helen Zimm is standing behind the bride, third from left. Inscribed in English: "Berlin 1947 / Wedding in Berlin Schlachtensee" and "120."
6. Photograph of a stone memorial with a Star of David on the top, with flowers at the base, the memorial plaque reads: "19.4.1973-19.4.1948/[Hebrew characters]/To the Martyrs and Heroes/of the Ghetto Uprising." Inscribed in Polish: "Wagnerstr. 1/Memingien/Bratman", "967 36 70."
