Identification card for foreigners issued by the Kingdom of Belgium to Selma Ordinans, November 4, 1942. Selma Ordinans was born in Poddebiez on June 24, 1892.

Identification card issued to Oscar Lewin, December 22, 1937. Oscar Lewin was born on May 13, 1888 in Warsaw, Poland.

Emigration card issued by the Governing Commission of the Nazi Government in Luxemburg.

Identification card issued to Jacques Lewin by the government of Luxemburg, valid until July 16, 1942. Jacques Lewin was born on May 25, 1922 to Mendel Nuchem (b. May 13, 1888) and Selma Ordinans (b. June 6, 1892).

Identification card issued to Jacques Lewin by the government of Luxemburg, 1942.

Allied Expeditionary Forced / Displaced Persons Index Card issued to Oscar Lewin with registration number L 00044715.

Liberation card from Ebensee concentration camp for Oscar Lewin, May 13, 1945. The card, a pre-printed form with typed text stating that Oscar Lewin, born on March 11, 1920 in Luxemburg was interned in the concentration camps of Germany and Austria between November 10, 1942 and May 6, 1945.

Alien registration certificate of Regina Baranova, issued by the United Kingdom, May 10, 1947.

Identification card issued by the French Office for the Protection of Refugees and Ex-patriots, November 12, 1954. The Director of the French Office of Protection of Refugees and [expatriots] certifies that Mme Baran nee Lewin Regina lives in Paris from May 14, 1913 from Warsaw (Poland); daughter of Max Lewin and of Zelma nee Ordynanz; is a refugee of Czechoslovakia; and that she is placed under the legal protection and administration of the Office. This certificate is valid between February 12, 1954 and February 12, 1957; Paris, 12 November 1954. The Director.
