Biographical note

The Bram family lived in Łomża, Poland prior to the Nazi invasion in 1939. Yankiel and his wife had seven children: Sonia, David, Hershel, Breina, Moshe, Waichi, and Esther. Hershel moved to Paraguay in 1938, and Sonia and Esther both survived being in Auschwitz concentration camp. The rest of the family is believed to have been killed there.
