Provenance: Officials of the Stutthof concentration camp created the records from 1939 to 1945. Muzeum Stutthof filmed the records for the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum Archives in 1995.

Organization and Arrangement: Organized in the following order: Reels 1 - 111 contain personal files on Poles and Polish Jews; Reels 112 -115 contain personal files on Russian Jews; Reels 152 - 208 and 214 - 216 contain personal files on prisoners of various nationalities; Reels 209 - 216 and 222 - 241 contain general administration files; Reels 216 - 221 contain "books of evidence" for prisoners; Reels 242 - 251 contain personnel files of SS staff at Stutthof; Reels 252 - 267 contain personal files on Hungarian Jews; Reels 267 -280 contain personal files on German Jews; and Reels 281 - 305 contain personal files on prisoners of various nationalities. Arrangement: Personal files on Jews of various nationalities are in general alphabetical order; Personal files on prisoners of "various nationalities" are in numerical order by prisoner number; Personnel files of SS staff are numerical by file number; "Books of evidence" are numerical by prisoner number; and general camp administration records are arranged thematically.

Scope and Content: Contains personal files on prisoners of Stutthof concentration camp; personnel files for SS staff at Stutthof; and records relating to the general administration of the camp. Administrative records include files from the camp commanders office, files from the "Political Department" concerning marking of prisoners and prisoner transports, files from the "Camp" relating to daily operations and handling of prisoners, files from the "Economic Administration" relating to financial management of the camp, files from the "Camp Physician" relating to medical services and the crematoria in the camp, files from the "Schooling and Education" department relating to training of SS staff, and files from the "Household shops for the SS" relating to building plans.

I Officer of the Commandant:

Signature (Sygn.) I-IA contains correspondence between the senior authorities about matters in Stuthoff; of the commandant's office with the senior authorities; other materials in the office of the commandant.

Sygn. I-IB contains orders, recommendations, instructions, general information, bulletins of the commandant, 1942-1945.

Sygn. I-IC contains communications, mail censors.

Sygn. I-ID contains general matters of the SS; company of guards; armaments; division of dogs in service.

Sygn. I-IE contains SS personnel files, SS personnel documents in alphabetical order.

Sygn. I-IF contains SS personnel and photo album of Himmler's visit to Stutthof.

II Political Department:

Sygn. I-IIA contains Department of correspondence; records of interrogations; marking of prisoners; and intercepted papers.

Sygn. I-IIB contains materials related to settlement of prisoners in Stutthof camp; correspondence in the matter of settlement of prisoners, 1941-1944; transport list of prisoners in Stutthof; and lists of transported prisoners.

Sygn. I-IIC contains materials related to the transports of prisoners; correspondence in the matters of transferring prisoners to other camps; list of freed prisoners; lists of dead prisoners.

Sygn. I-IID contains documents of prisoners; personal questionnaires of prisoners; personal index and files of prisoners; photo documents of prisoners.

IV Economic Administration:

Sygn. I-IVB contains financial propositions, allowances, and economics; financial settlement, accounting of business for work of prisoners; suggestions for premium for prisoners; payments and other pays for staff; payments for protection.

Sygn. I-IVC contains material management supplying the camp with furniture, etc.; supplying with printed materials and files; inventory of objects; warehouse.

Sygn. I-IVD contains economic dealings; horses; gardening.

Sygn. I-IVE contains deposit prisoners and objects; depositing of prisoners' clothing; correspondence regarding sending belongings of dead prisoners and freed prisoners; valuables robbed and plundered.

Sygn. I-IVF contains deposits of prisoners money in cash taken away; paid out money from prisoners accounts; books sent by mail to prisoners.

Sygn. I-IVG contains information on SS clothing warehouse; supplies of clothing for the staff.

Sygn. I-IVH warehouse for prisoners clothing; supplies for prisoners; supplies for camps.

Sygn. I-IVI kitchen supplies of food products; housekeeping books for accounting; food allotments to equal rations.
