#### Scope and content of collection

The records of the entire Fond 709, 1871-1938 (45 Dela) features documents of the Jewish Religious Community of Graz and Jewish organizations. Including are minutes, correspondence, circulars, records on real estate and financial assets, community financial statements, a card files and lists of the community members, voter lists, questionnaires of individuals joining the committee for social security, articles on the history of community, catalog of books in the library of Rabbi S. Műsam and international bulletins. Includes also documents on aid to Jewish emigrants, reports from the Jewish communities in Augsburg and from various Jewish educational centers.

The selected records include: Minutes, reports on teachers' incompetence in a Jewish school in Prague, and information on a variety of issues affecting the Jewish community in Graz.
