Historical Note

The gendarmerie mobile squad in Radomsko (Gendarmerie Zug Radomsko) emerged in early October 1939. Officially it reported to/was subordinate to the Commander of Gendarmerie in the District of Radom (Kommandeur der Gendarmerie in Distrikt Radom). Numerous regional precincts were subordinate to it. The Gendarmerie was a formation of the Nazi order police. Its posts were densely scattered throughout small towns and villages, and were supported by a well-developed network of informers and spies that consisted mainly of local Volksdeutsche, who were used to keep the Polish community under close surveillance. The police in occupied Poland, along with their basic duties, i.e. keeping order, actively participated in the deportation of Poles and Jews to the GG, and organized the hunting and round-ups of Poles to send them as forced labor to the Third Reich. It closely co-operated with the Gestapo and Sipo of the Third Reich against the Polish resistance movement.

Scope and Content of Collection

This collection contains orders and instructions of the Chief Officer of Gendarmerie in Radom, including daily and situational reports of individual gendarmerie precincts (Stützpunkte).

System of Arrangement

The system of arrangement of the source repository has been preserved on the microfilm reels, Orders and Instructions are arranged in a chronological order.

Historical Background: Oddział Lotny Żandarmerii w Radomsku (Gendarmerie Zug Radomsko) pojawił się w Radomsku na początku października 1939 r. Organizacyjnie podlegał Komendantowi Żandarmerii w Dystrykcie Radomskim (Kommandeur der Gendarmerie in Distrikt Radom). Oddziałowi temu podlegały liczne posterunki terenowe. Żandarmeria była formacją, hitlerowskiej policji porządkowej. Jej placówki gęsto rozsiane po małych miasteczkach i wsiach, wspomagane przez dobrze rozwinięta sieć konfidentów i szpiegów złożoną głównie z miejscowych Volksdeutschów, głęboko indoktrynowały polską społeczność. Policja na okupowanych ziemiach polskich obok swych podstawowych zadań, to jest utrzymania ładu i porządku, zwalczania przestępstw gospodarczych, zwłaszcza nielegalnego handlu, uboju oraz produkcji bimbru, brała aktywny udział w akcji wysiedlania Polaków i Żydów do GG, organizowania obław i łapanek Polaków na roboty przymusowe do III Rzeszy. W sprawach politycznych, a zwłaszcza polskiego ruchu oporu, ściśle współpracowała z gestapo i policją bezpieczeństwa III Rzeszy.
