58. Kiev oblast committee of the Union for the Rebirth of Russia: Appeal on the liberation of Kiev from the invasion of Bolshevik pogromists. Appeal not to believe provocative rumors, not to succumb to anti-Semitic propaganda. Russian
59. Poaley-Sion: Vote for list No. 2—the United ESRP. Russian. Ekaterinoslavskiy election district.
