Moisey Beregovsky (1892-1961) was a leading researcher of Jewish musical heritage, prominent Jewish musicologist, editor of the five-volume collection "The Jewish Musical Folklore," and professor of Kiev Conservatory. During his folklore expeditions, he recorded remnants of the Yiddish songs of the last inhabitants of what was once the shtetlakh of the Pale of Settlement, as well as new melodies of the Jewish" workers and peasants," voices of prominent figures of the Jewish culture as Solomon Mikhoels and Mikhail Gnessin
