Two name lists, dated 30 April 1943 and 10 June 1943, of the personnel of the Belgian Union des Juifs, with a supplementary list of employees dated 6 July 1943. Four lists of employees of the special cases branch.

List of Jews deported from Malines (the Dossin barracks) in Convoy VIII on 8 September 1942.

List of Jews deported from Malines (the Dossin barracks) in Convoy XIII on 10 October 1942.

List of Jews deported from Malines (the Dossin barracks) in Convoy III on 15 August 1942.

List, dated 28 August 1942, of Jews deported from Malines (the Dossin barracks) in Convoy VI on 29 August 1942.

List, dated 15 January 1943, of people deported from Brussels and Forest neighborhoods, who did not have ration cards.

Press clipping taken from *Le Soir*, dated Thursday 9 September 1943, concerning the Italian surrender.

Press clipping taken from *Le Soir*, dated Thursday 17 December 1942, written by Franz Briel, titled *Les dogmes de la Révolution*.

Handbill from the Independent Front of the Regional Committee of Brussels, calling citizens and resistance fighters alike to mobilize for the liberation of the country.

Anti-American propaganda brochure, titled *USA, la plus grande démocratie*.

Press clipping from *Ons Volk*, Brussels, dated 17 June 1945.
