**Restrictions on access:** Restrictions on access for microfilm reel #3 and corresponding digital images. Records are closed until 2018. Researchers must submit written request to the Director of the Indre-et-Loire Archives for access.

**Restrictions on use:** Permission must be requested from the Director of the Departmental Archives of the Indre-et-Loire to reproduce the films or digital images.

**Organization and arrangement:** Arrangement is thematic.

**Language:** In French.

**Preferred citation:** Standard citation for the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum Collections Division, Archives Branch.

**Scope and Content:** Records about the Camp-de-la-Lande-à-Monts; the Germans' massacre of French civilians in the town of Maillé; the German administration of Jewish matters; and the Roma. Collection includes lists of Jews in Indre-et-Loire from 1939 to 1946, a 1940 census, lists of "undesirables" and "indigents" (1941–1942), and information on the internment of Jews (1940–1944).
