Custodial history: After the war, the records appear to have been used by the "Service Evacuation Regroupement" of the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee, which compiled some of

the lists of internees that are included in the collection from 1946. It was later cataloged by the Centre de Documentation Juive Contemporaine (CDJC) as Cotes LVIII-LXIVa (58-64a) and filmed for Yad Vashem as JM/574.

Administrative history

Le Camp du Vernet d'Ariège was originally established in the Midi-Pyrenees region of Southern France in 1939 for internments relating to the end of the Spanish Civil War.

Its purpose was expanded at the start of World War II later that year, and again under Vichy in 1940. Beginning in 1942, it began to serve as a transit camp for the deportation of local Jews.

Many of the internees were arrested or sought by Vichy prior to 1942, and were consequently held as threats to public order, often based on some past activity or offense rather than for being Jews as such.

The last deportation from Vernet took place in June 1944.

Scope and content of collection

The collection contains records relating to internment in the Camp at Vernet. It consists of files on 104 individual internees rather than the camp as a whole, documenting the process of their apprehension and detailing information including:

- Name
- Alias
- Nationality
- Place of Birth
- Offense
- Religion

Additional lists at towards the end of the collection denote whether internees escaped or were deported, liberated, or repatriated. Not all internees are listed under one of these headings. The records cover a period from August 1940 up to the last deportation in June 1944.

System of arrangement

The original order of the collection (provided by the 1946 JDC list towards the end along with legacy data) ordered and numbered each internee file alphabetically by last name, with documents within each file being arranged chronologically.

The order in which they were filmed is quite different, although the CDJC sought to apply cotation numbers corresponding to the original numbering, this is only true for numbers 1-15, 29-38 and 70-104 (105-109 being separate lists).

Others are incorrectly arranged, most notably the lengthy Monossohn file which is split between reels with intervening material. This may have been compounded during duplication, as the closest approximation of alphabetical order is currently obtained by arranging the USHMM reels in the order 4, 5, 3, 2, 1.

The title assigned to the collection is that used by CJDC.
