Title: Selected Records from the Hauptstaatsarchiv NSDAP (NS 26), 1932-1941.

Extent: 46 microfilm reels.

Provenance: Original records located in the Bundesarchiv, Berlin, Germany. The United States Holocaust Memorial Museum's International Archives Project received the microfilm in March 2004 through its mutual microfilm exchange program.

Biographical/historical note: The Hauptstaatsarchiv NSDAP was formed in Berlin in January 1934 as the archive of the Reichspropaganda office and later moved to Munich. In 1939, the archive began to collect NSDAP administrative documents as well as documents pertaining to Jews, Communists, Freemasons, and others deemed "undesirable". The majority of the archive's holdings were destroyed during the war.

Restrictions on Access: Restrictions on access. To access Bundesarchiv collections researchers must fill out a "Request for Access to Bundesarchiv Documents." German and English language copies of the "Law on the Preservation and Use of the German Federal Archival Documents" are available at the Archives reference desk. The Bundesarchiv stipulated the requirement in the cooperative agreement signed with the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum.

Restriction on Use: Restrictions on use. Requests for reproduction must be directed to the Bundesarchiv. A copy of all publications based on its material must be provided to the Bundesarchiv. Researchers may not publish any Bundesarchiv material on the Internet, the World Wide Web, or any other publicly accessible on-line network without permission from the Bundesarchiv.

Organization and Arrangement: Arrangement is thematic.

Language: German

Preferred Citation: Standard citation for the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum Collections Division, Archives Branch.

Scope and Content: Contains a variety of administrative documents created by the NSDAP, including procedural guidelines, SA reports, speeches, correspondence, personnel files, minutes of meetings, and information on groups deemed inimical to Nazi ideology.

General use note: A concordance with brief German-language descriptions for all of the reference numbers listed below is available in the Archives administrative file. Note that in most cases, individual files contain only selected documents from that file (designated by the letter "E" next to the folder description of that file). Some folders were filmed in their entirety (designated by the letter "G" next to the folder descriptions of that file). Further, a comprehensive English-language finding aid for the entire NSDAP Hauptarchiv (of which this collection is only a fragment) is available in the library under call number DD253.2N73 1964, and provides detailed folder-level descriptions for all of the file numbers listed below, complete with a proper-name and place-name index.
