Organization and Arrangement: Organized into two parts: (1) documents 1935-1945 and (2) Periodicals, 1864-1945.

Scope and content note: Contains mostly regulations, correspondence, reports and the like, compiled by French authorities in Morocco. Main topics are: legislation related to Jews; Moroccan and Algerian laws concerning Jews; professions prohibited to Jews (1941-1942 records); records on taxes levied on the Jewish community (1940-1945); decrees concerning nationality and citizenship of Jews; 1930-1935 tax matters related to the Jewish community; Jewish cemeteries; Jewish life in Fez; German activity in Morocco before and during the war, including notes of the DAP (Deutsche Arbeitspartei); activities in the Spanish zone of Morocco; and German propaganda aimed towards Muslims. The collection also contains periodicals; Titles of the periodicals (bulk 1925-1945) include: *Annales nord Marocaines, Bulletin de l'association des anciens eleves de l'alliance Israelite Rabat, Noar, Revue des etudes islamiques, L'avenir illustré, L'univers Israelite: journal des conversations du Judaisme*, and (1864-1913) *Bulletin de l'alliance Israelite.*
