Zwi Golombek

RG-50.106*0097

Born in Warsaw, Poland on September 15, 1934

Father had large construction business

Warsaw Ghetto formed - family moves into one room on Novolypke Street, father could exit and enter because he possessed building permits

Zwi aware of danger, saw beatings, children not returning

Early 1942 - Father struck German guard, taken away to ghetto prison, then
Treblinka

July 1942 - Uncle Mietek places Zwi in Abramzuc family in Josefow

2 weeks later, mother and sister disappear from Ghetto

Zwi stays hidden in house for 3 years. Uncle visits often and pays family. Shoved in cupboard or hole in ground when people come, called Henyek

Uncle comes at end of war - places him in kibbutzim in Poland and Germany

October 6, 1948 - goes to Israel

Works in Tel Aviv - joins Israeli army in 1952, fights wars in 1956, 1967, 1973, 1982

Married - lives in Tel Aviv, has 2 sons
