

Lore Schneider (born Heti Lore Koppel)

Lore Schneider was born on October 10, 1924 in Bochum, Germany. Schneider's mother had a sister in the United States who vouched for them, and in June of 1934, Schneider and her parents left Germany. When they arrived in the United States, the Koppel's settled in Washington, D.C. Lore attended public school and graduated at sixteen. She, and her parents, obtained United States citizenship in 1939, five years after their arrival. During the war, Lore attended college at night and worked full time during the day as a stenographer at the Interior Department. Lore married in 1946, and had three children.
