

Frank Nathan Liebermann (born Franz Natan Liebermann)

Frank Liebermann was born in Gleiwitz, Poland on January 19, 1929 and describes his family; immigrating to the United States in October 1938 and moving to Dayton, Ohio, where his father set up his medical practice; his family's involvement in the Jewish community and helping many European Jews to immigrate to the United States; attending Western Reserve University; meeting his wife during his sophomore year and marrying her soon after he graduated; working for a textile converting firm for many years before retiring and moving to Washington, D.C., where his two daughters had already settled; finding a job at a travel firm; and beginning to volunteer at the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum after September 11th.
