SUMMARY: David Cahane - 88 years old, already a rabbi in 1941 in Lemberg (Lvov), eastern Galicia, when the Germans occupied the city. Gives a rare account of a rabbi, a member of Lvov's rabbinate, who opposed the Judenrat, which cooperated with the Germans. Subsequently imprisoned in Janowska; manged to escape from there. Afterwards hidden by the Ukrainian Greek Catholic metropolitan of Lvov, Sheptytsky. After the war, served as the chief rabbi of Poland.
