SUMMARY: Born in 1921 at Cluj, Transylvania, Romania, put under Hungarian rule from 1940. On May 1944 transported to Auschwitz together with her fiance, her mother, and three brothers. Her family was exterminated after a selection by Dr. Mengele. In November 1944 was made to march by foot to Hainichen near Dresden, Germany, and became a forced labourer in a canons' factory. In May 1945 she was transported by train to Thereienstadt, and liberated there. Since then she never lost hope that her fiance is still alive and had never had any other relationship with a man.
