SUMMARY: Born in 1923 at Suceava, a city in Bucovina, north Romania. Brought up in an orthodox family but as a young boy joined the Communist movement. Describes the Romanian antisemitism as it was growing at the beginning of the war. Expelled with his family to Transnistria and from 1942 to 1944 lived in the ghetto of Shergorod, where his parents died of hunger. Gives a detailed description of the struggle to survive, the diseases, malnutrition, misery, and hunger of the Jewish refugees in Transnistria. Liberated by the Red Army, returned to his native city and from there made 'aliyya' to Eretz, Israel.
