SUMMARY: Uziel Lichtenberg - from Lodz, a member of Hanoar Hazioni. A soldier in the Polish army who was captured by the Germans and freed. Returned to the Lodz ghetto; from there went to the Warsaw ghetto. One of the founders of the Hanoar Hazioni kibbutz in the ghetto and the farm in Grochov. Attempted to open up the border to Hungary via Slovakia to sane members of the movement. Was in refugee camps and concentration camps in Hungary. Active in the Assistance and Rescue Committee and the Polish Refugee Committee. Reached Palestine in the beginning of 1994. Was a member of Kibbutz Nitzanim.
