TAPE I

- 1.05 Lili Ofek [nee Ticho] was born in Vienna in 1923. Describes her large close family who was assimilated but kept Jewish traditions. Family lived in Florisdorf across the Danube. She describes anti-Semitism in school.
- 1.10 March 1938, when Hitler entered Austria, she was thrown out of school and went to school for Jewish children directed by a Nazi. Describes was happened to Jews.
- 1.23 Family tried in vain to leave Vienna. In Dec. 1938 she went to Holland with a group of children. Describes trip and arrival in children's home.
- 1.30 Her parents escaped to Czechoslovakia and when the Germans entered they went illegally to Palestine.
- 1.36 She describes her adjustment and life, with 40 other children, in Lostrech. She was supposed to leave for Palestine in 1940 when war broke out in Holland.
- 1.42 Describes Holland under German rule. Special rules for Jews. She went to Amsterdam to learn baby care.
- 1.48 She is saved from going to a labor camp in Germany, and is taken care of by Jewish underground.
- 1.59 Talks about Jop, who saved children and was head of the underground.
- 2.02 Describes life and conditions in the Lustrech children's house.
- 2.31 Describes the work of Erika Bluht and other counselors.
- 2.38 She and all the children are taken to Westerbork. Describes her work in a factory.
- 2.45 Describes how she got out of Westerbork to the underground in Amsterdam, from there to Rotterdam and from there to a safe house in Sevenum[?].
- 3.02 Describes underground which helped Jews as well as escaped soldiers and shot down pilots. Describes her life with a peasant family and the support of the village and church.
- 3.14 The fate of her boyfriend.
- 3.18 Her meeting with Jop, head of the underground.
