WILLIAM KAMMAN

Born 4/24 St Paul, MN. Jewish High school in St. Paul. Some antisemitism although school half Jewish. Army 1943-5. Sent to Europe 12/44. Assigned to a reconnaissance unit in the 10th Armored Division. Crossed the Rhine into Germany 3/45. His unit came upon Dachau but he never went in. Saw inmates in striped clothe moving around looking for food. "Looked like they were dead." This was his only contact with the camps. Knows David (who was liberated by his unit) and Barbabra Eiger and Dora Zaudenweber, Holcaust survivors. Does not like German people. Has a German client who claims his father told the Jews to get out of Germany early on.
