

Synopsis of interview of Frank Jenner.
Melbourne, Australia 21/11/95

Frank Jenner [nee Gazirovsky(ph)] was born on January 2, 1920 in Duesseldorf ,Germany. He describes his youth in Duesseldorf and Wuppertal, Germany. Frank did not experience much antisemitism until well into the Nazi period. In 1938 he was counseled to join a Jewish training farm for young people. During Kristallnacht, Frank and other students over 18 were arrested and taken to Buchenwald concentration camp in Germany. He briefly describes conditions in the camp. Frank was released in early 1939, when he received a visa to Australia, which was in need of agricultural workers. He arrived in Australia in the summer of 1939, and worked for two years on farms.
