

Synopsis of interview with Anna Danko, Melbourn, Australia Holocaust Centre, 11-15-1995

Anna Danko (nee Gruenfeld) was born June 29, 1924 in Vereck Berchova(ph) near Munkacz, Czechoslovakia. She came from a religious family, her brothers attended Yeshiva in Bratislava. The area where she came from became part of Hungary during the war. She describes formation of the ghetto and eventual deportation to Auschwitz. She mentioned the fact that she and her sister were able to help many fellow prisoners while in camp. Eventually she wound up in Ravensbrück and then in Reichshof, traveling by foot and by cattle car. She was liberated by the Russian army.
