

Interview of Serry Wolf

Serry Wolf-Gans was born in 1927 in Winterswijk, The Netherlands. Her father had a wholesale knitwear business and the family was strictly observant. In 1943, the family went into hiding but was subsequently betrayed. Though the rest of her family was arrested, Serry managed to escape by jumping out of a window. After her family was deported, Serry found a new hiding place, where she stayed until two months before liberation. She and a friend then started walking towards the liberators. She finally met up with Scottish troops somewhere in Germany.

She married another survivor and the couple decided to immigrate first to New Zealand, and then to Australia. The family is still strictly observant.
