SUMMARY

Hannah Heyman, nee Gruenfelder, was born in Munich on June 12, 1924 into an assimilated Jewish family. She describes at age 12 being forced to leave public school and swim club. She describes Jewish school. Following *Kristallnacht* in 1938 her father was taken to Dachau and subsequently returned. Hannah and her younger brother were sent to Amsterdam in 1939. Her parents received permits to leave Germany for England in 1938, where the children were able to join them in 1939. In 1940 the family came to the United States.
