Summary: Lisa Brinner was born in Austria. At age 15, she was put on the Kindertransport to London and eventually found herself in San Francisco. In 1940, Lisa's parents left Vienna and journeyed to Moscow, Vladivostok, Korea/Northern China, Japan, and eventually to San Francisco by August 1940. They had to make that journey because France had fallen, but the Hitler-Stalin Pact was still in place. Lisa's younger brother accompanied Lisa to her foster family's home in England, and they immigrated to San Francisco together.

Many photographs and documents were videotaped at the end.
