And that says that you were released from Flossenbürg in 1945.

That picture that we're seeing now was taken of you?

Yeah.

After the war?

After the war.

Uh-huh. Do you remember where that was, or when?

This was in Landsberg Am Lech in Kibbutz Borochoy.

Mm-hmm.

And the picture to the right? What is that picture?

This, I was in [PLACE NAME].

With your husband?

Yeah. We went--

Were you married yet?

We went-- Huh?

Were you married yet in that picture?

I was married already, yeah.

And right below it?

Below it is my--

Is your wedding.

My wedding.

Wedding picture. So you were a-- you had a real gown and?

Yes. My wedding, we went out from the-- I was living already in camp. When my wedding was, I was living in camp already.

In the DP camp?

Yo-- yeah-- In Landsberg, Landsberg Am Lech, yeah. We went out to the ceremony. He didn't want to come in the camp.

That's the picture in the car?

So we want the ceremony outside. He went back to--

Uh-huh. That's good.

We have a orthodox rabbi. And he didn't want to-- I went to the mikvah.

Yeah?

He didn't want to give me-- well, I didn't want-- [NON-ENGLISH], no mikvah. I went to the mikvah. Yeah?

Yeah.

What--

And this is a photo of your oldest daughter?

Yeah.

And her family?

And her family.

And this is a number of years ago?

Yeah.

Yeah. Do you remember when this was taken?

She-- they were small.

Uh-huh.

Long time ago.

Uh-huh. OK. And this is your younger daughter with her children?

With the kid, with the children, yes.

And also a number of years ago.

Yeah. We did so, so lovely.

OK. And this is a more recent picture. Do you know when this was taken?

Yeah, we went for vacation this. We went for vacation a cruise.

Just a few years ago, or?

Oh, this was three years ago. I think three years ago, three or four years ago.

You, your husband, and your?

My daughter.

Oldest daughter?

Yeah. My son-in-law, I don't remember. No, he was not there with my daughter. They went someplace else.
