## Kuzak, Helena eyewitnessed:

An elderly Jew was shot during the ghetto liquidation for walking too slow.

**Resistance** After the liquidation of the ghetto the Germans lured Jews who escaped during the liquidation, to return to town with the promise of work. Mostly young Jews returned. In summer of 1943 the Germans attempted to liquidate those Jews who lived in one building. Jews resisted with some weapons and threw grenades at the Germans. Finally the Germans burned the wooden building. Everyone inside was killed.
