

Frederick Richard Wohl

Interview of February 13, 2004, follow-up to interview of November 22, 1989

Summary

Frederick Richard Wohl, born June 7, 1914, describes his family's prominence in Baden-Baden; his two sisters who perished during the Holocaust; his first wife Lillian Eisenberg and his second wife, Evelyn Mitzner; his various apprenticeships as a young man; his voluntary relocations to Athens, Greece, Nicosia, Cyprus, and East Africa; immigrating to the United States and eventually residing in Washington, D. C., where he became a licensed insurance agent; his two daughters Jacqueline Diane Wohl (Tinney) and Valerie Ann Wohl; working as a life insurance salesman in Maryland; and his volunteer work in precinct politics, B'nai B'rith, and the Masonic Lodge.
