## **Evaluation/further information about interview:**

Ann Klein was born in Eger, Hungary, in 1921, and spent the war years there, and in Auschwitz and Ravensbruck concentration camps. She emigrated to the US in 1947, and settled in Louisville in 1953 with her husband, who had been her childhood sweetheart. Interview focused on issues of education, tradition (Judaism, raising children), postwar friendships; her expectations and preconceptions about the US, and her life in Louisville. Discussed her son in some detail; he was killed in an accident.
